

Baby Bear Hat

Needles: 5mm/ Size 8,

Double Pointed Needles (DPN), set of 4

Yarn: Worsted Weight/Wool Ease Other. Needle, to weave in ends

Gauge: 5 stitches per inch or 20 sts/4 in. *Fits newborns. Diameter: 5.5inches.*

(11inches, without stretch)

K2tog = knit two together

Hat

Cast on 50 stitches, distributing stitches on 3 DPNs (17, 17, 16)

- 1. Join in the round and knit 3.5 inches.
- 2. *Knit 3, K2tog* **repeat
- 3. Knit 3 rounds.
- 4. *Knit 2, K2tog* **repeat
- 5. Knit 2 rounds.
- 6. *Knit 1, K2tog* **repeat
- 7. Knit 1 round.
- 8. *K2tog* **repeat
- Break yarn and thread through remaining stitches. Pull tight and weave in ends.

Ears

This is the tricky part. You will be picking up the 8 bars between



8 stitches - on each side. Like this:

For each ear:

- Knit four rounds (garter stitch)
- 2. K2tog, knit 4, K2tog
- 3. K2tog, knit 2, K2tog
- 4. K2tog, K2tog
- 5. K2tog
- 6. Break yarn and pull through last stitch. This may cause a point, but you can round it out as you weave in the ends.
- 7. Weave in ends.
