

a Girly Knits pattern by Lauren Riker

"Chic Cowl

Why not keep your neck warm in the chillier months this year in style? This super cute and subtly sparkly cowl neck scarf keeps you cozy while dressing up your outfit! This fabulous fun yarn provides an adventure in itself to knit - it actually changes yarns for you, with each skein containing 6 different yarns! From soft, to fuzzy, to funky, you'll get to experience knitting it all (my favorite part is the super sparkly lurex :) The cowl neck scarf features 6 cables running up it for added luxe. Knit in the round, the only finishing you will need to do is weave in the tails from the cast on and bind off edges. It only uses one ball, so for a small investment you get a fabulous new accessory. Difficulty: Intermediate

Size: One Size

Finished Measurements:

Circumfrence: 24" Length: 10.75"

Gauge:

13 sts and 20 rows = 4" in St st

Materials:

- Red Heart Boutique Changes (bulky weight; 87%) acrylic, 12% wool, 1% other fibers; 187yd/171m per 100g skein): 1 skein Granite #9403
- ♥ US 10.5 (6.5mm) 16" circular needle
- Stitch marker
- Cable Needle
- Tapestry needle

Abbreviations:

- beg: begin(ning)(s)
- BO: bind off
- c6f: sl 3 sts to cn and hold to front. k3, k3 from cn
- cn: cable needle
- CO: cast on
- ♥ k: knit
- p: purl
- pm: place marker
- rnd(s): round(s)
- rep(s): repeat(s)
- sl: slip
- st(s): stitch(es)
- St st: stockinette stitch

Directions: Are you excited? Here we go!

Scarf

CO 96 sts. Pm for beg of rnd and join, taking care not to twist sts.

Rnds 1&2: *P1, k6, p1, k8; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 3: *P1, c6f, p1, k8; rep from * to end of rnd.

Rnds 4-8: Rep rnd 1.

Rnd 9: Rep rnd 3.

Rep rnds 4-9 eight times.

Rep rnds 1&2 again.

BO.

Finishing

Weave in ends.

Now put it on and feel glamourous!


