

CHUNKY TEXTURED LOOP

HELLOhappy!

to make me,
you will need:

-6mm hook



-ww yarn in 2 colors, one full skein from any popular brand should be enough, but if you have a larger neck you might want to get 2 skeins of each color.

-yarn needle

First, we'll need to chain. A lot.

If you're making this for yourself, well then easy peasy, just chain until it's long enough it comfortably fit around your head & neck twice. If it's for someone else, the average female neck circumference is 14-15 inches, for men it's 15-16 inches. For children, ask google lol

I made this pretending I had a 14" neck and my cowl is 58" with 191 chains. My neck is actually 12" so this cowl is just a little bigger than I'd prefer to wear it. But this size should work for most teen and adult women.

End your chain on an odd number, then join with the beginning of your chain, and you will have an even number. The rest of the cowl is worked in the round. Now for Row1, sc around once.

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R2: *3yo puff stitch, chain1, skip1* repeat

R3: HDC in each st

R4: HDC in each st through back loops **only**

R5: repeat R4

R6-R9: repeat R2-R5

R10-R13: repeat R2-R5

Now switch colors and do R2-R13 with the new color

After you've re-done R13 with the new color, do 2 more rows. The first will be sc, and the last row will be sl st. Now you're done! Weave in your ends.



^^^ When you are doing R3, make your HDC into the **space** between each puff, rather than into **the chain** between each puff.
