

FUZZY BUBBLE COWL

HELLOhappy!



to make me,
you will need:

-6.5 mm hook

-some kind of ww or bulky weight fuzzy yarn. Or not fuzzy. Really, you can use any yarn! (if you use super bulky, go up to an 8 or 9mm hook)

-yarn needle



Okay, let's go!

Chain 13

Do a 4 yo puff stitch into the 12th chain (the one before the one you just did)
Slip stitch into the 11th st (the one before the chain you just puffed into) (lol)

Now from where you are now, chain 13 again, do a 4yo puff into the previous chain, then slip stitch into the one before that. Repeat this until your length is long enough. It depends on how many times you want to wrap it, if you want it to fit tightly or loosely.



I forgot to measure mine, but since this is a free pattern I'm not going to go back and do it now. :P but basically, here it is at the final length. You can see that wrapping it around twice brings it right at the top of my chest. I wasn't planning to be able to wrap it around 3 times, but I ended up being able to do it anyway. So just keep going until it's long enough.

Once it's long enough, chain 1 and join it with a slip

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Allrighty. Now chain 7 and make your 4yo into the 6th chain, then slip stitch into the 5th chain...yeah, you're getting it. Now chain 5, then slip stitch into the puff from the starting chain. Now mark the start of the row, because it's gonna be reeeally hard to find later lol.



You just want to repeat that ch7, 4yo, sl st, ch5, sl st forever until your cowl is as thick as you want. I only had half a skein so I only had enough for 5 rows, but I would have doubled that if I could have.



It's difficult to keep this piece orderly, I highly recommend you use your knees to hold it, and just rotate it as you go.



Once it's thick enough, finish it with a chain 5 & slip stitch. Now weave in your ends.

Simply, easy and adorable!
