

Wendy's Cluster Hat

Crochet pattern for intermediate or studious beginner crochet artists.

Hook Size: 7 or 4.5mm

Yarn Weight: Fine (2)

Hat will fit your average adult.

It is about 23 inches in circumference.



Techniques and Terminology

sl = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

scs = multiple single crochets

cl = cluster of 3 double crochets

how to:

*yarn over
insert hook into space
yarn over
pull up 1 loop
yarn over
pull up 2 loops
repeat from * twice more
(three times total)
there are 4 loops on your hook
yarn over
pull through all loops

ch = chain

bcl = beginning cluster

(this is my personal notation for the first cluster of a new row)

how to:

chain 2
*yarn over
insert hook into join space
yarn over
pull up 1 loop
yarn over
pull up 2 loops
repeat from * once more
(twice total)
there are 3 loops on your hook
yarn over
pull through all loops

Directions

Beginning

ch 5. join with sl to create ring

Round 1

into ring: bcl, *ch 2, cl* (repeat between *s 3 more times)

ch 1, sc into top of first cluster to join (5 clusters)

Round 2

bcl into sc join from last round, ch 2, [cl, ch 2, cl ch 2] into each of the next 4 spaces

cl into last space (the chain 1 before the join)

ch 1, sc into top of first cluster to join (10 clusters)

Round 3

bcl into join, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, *[cl, ch2, cl] into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, repeat from * around

cl into last space

ch 1, sc into top of first cluster to join (15 clusters)

Round 4

bcl into join, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, *[cl, ch2, cl] into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, repeat from * around.

cl into last space

ch 1, sc into top of first cluster to join (20 clusters)

Round 5

bcl into join, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, *[cl, ch2, cl] into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, cl into next space, ch 2, repeat from * around

cl into last space

do not chain! sc into top of first cluster to join (25 clusters)

Rounds 6 – 14 (9 rounds)

bcl into join, *ch 2, cl into next space, repeat from * around

sc into top of first cluster to join (25 clusters)

Round 15

bcl into join, *ch 2, cl into next space, repeat from * around

ch 1, sl into top of first cluster to join (25 clusters)

Round 16

ch 1

*2 sc into cluster, 1 sc into each chain, repeat from * around

sl into first sc to join (100 scs)

Round 17 – 19 (3 rounds)

ch 1

sc into Back Loop Only around

sl into first sc to join (100 scs)

Fasten off and you're done!!
