

CAMAS
SLOUCHY GARTER & LACE HAT

MATERIALS

Shown in Hazel Knits Cadence, colorway Jam Session (warm purple, 1 skein), 200 yards (183 m) /110 grams per skein.

OR worsted weight, 160 (180, 200) yards. [146 (165, 183) m.] Note: Largest size uses full yardage of skein; you may want to purchase additional yarn.

Tools

Size 5 US (3.75 mm) and 7 (4.5 mm) 16" (41 cm) circular needles; size 7 double pointed needles, or size to obtain correct gauge.

Tapestry needle, stitch marker.

GAUGE

19 stitches and 31 rows / 4 inches (10 cm) in Lace Stripe Pattern on larger needles, lightly blocked.


SIZING

Finished size 18.5" (20.2", 22") [47 (51, 56) cm] for 20" (22", 24") head [51 (56, 61) cm]

Shown in 20.2" (51 cm) finished size.

FINISHING NOTES

For best results, soak in lukewarm water with appropriate wool wash. Squeeze excess water from hat. Lay damp hat out flat so that the garter stitch of the brim stays compact and the body of hat is gently blocked.



LACE STRIPE PATTERN

knit

- purl

yarn over

∠ k2tog

 λ ssk

→ p2tog

→ sk2p

chart repeat

PATTERN

CAST ON:

Using cable cast-on and smaller circular needle, CO 88 (96, 104) stitches. Join in the round, being careful not to twist, using Crossover Join as follows:

Slip first stitch of cast-on pwise onto right needle; pass last st of cast-on (2nd st on right needle) over this st and place on left needle. **Pm** between these two sts for beginning of round.

BRIM:

Purl I round.

Work Rounds 1-2 a total of 7 times, or until cuff measures 1.5" (3.8 cm) from cast-on edge, ending after Row 2.

Round 1: K across. Round 2: P across.



BODY:

Switch to larger needles. Using chart or written instructions, work Rounds 1-22 of Lace Stripe Pattern twice, then work Rounds 1-10 once more.

Lace Stripe Pattern

Round 1: K across.

Rounds 2, 4, 6, & 8: K across.

Round 3: *KI, yo, ssk, k3, k2tog, yo* to end of round.

Round 5: *K2, yo, ssk, k1, k2tog, yo, k1* to end of round.

Round 7: *K3, yo, sk2p, yo, k2* to end of round.

Round 9: K across.

Rounds 10, 12 & 14: P across.

Rounds 11 & 13: K across.

Round 15: *Yo, p2tog* to end of round.

Round 16: K across.

Round 17: *P2tog, yo* to end of round.

Rounds 18, 20 & 22: P across.

Rounds 19 & 21: K across.

CROWN:

Work crown shaping, moving to DPNs when work becomes too small for circular needles:

Round 1: *K2tog* across.

Rounds 2-8: Work as for Rounds 12-18 of Lace Stripe Pattern.

Round 9: *K2tog* across.

Rounds 10-12: Work as for Rounds 20-22 of Lace Stripe Pattern.

Round 13: *K2tog* across.

After working these 13 rounds, 11 (12, 13) stitches remain. Cut 12" (39 cm) tail and draw through remaining stitches.

Block according to FINISHING NOTES.

SYMBOLS & NOTATION

k	knit	k2tog	knit 2 together
p	purl	ssk	slip, slip, knit: (sl 1 as if to knit) twice; k2tog through back loop
СО	cast on	yo	yarn over
pm	place marker	sk2p	slip I kwise, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over
*	beg. & end of repeat

YARN

I skein Hazel Knits Cadence, colorway **Jam Session OR worsted weight**, 160-200 yards. [146-183 m.]

NEEDLES

Size 5 US (3.75 mm) 16"(41 cm) circular needles Size 7 US (4.5 mm) 16" (41 cm) circular needles Size 7 double pointed needles
