

## **Garden Paths Doily**


This pattern is a reworking of a vintage doily that I found in my Grandmother's sewing box.

The centre features cluster stitches, whilst the border has a combination of solid panels









and lacy panels.

I thought that the lacy panels looked rather like paths and they suggested the layout of a formal garden, so this is the reason for the name of the pattern.

The doily measures approximately 25 cm / 10 inches in diameter at its widest point. You will need:

Crochet cotton in white, I used Coats crochet cotton #12 Hook size 1.75mm

## Please note that English crochet terms are used throughout

tr= USA dc dc = USA sc

## Special abbreviation

tr3(4)tog (cluster) = \*yarn over hook, insert hook in next stitch, yarn over hook, draw loop through, yarn over hook, draw through 2 loops (2 loops left on hook)\* yarn over hook, insert hook into next stitch, yarn over hook, draw loop through, yarn over hook, draw through 2 of the loops on the hook, (3 loops left on the hook) rep from \* 1 (2) times more (4 (5) loops on hook), yarn over hook and draw through all the loops on the hook.

## **PATTERN**

With white crochet cotton and 1.75 mm hook, ch 4. Join into a ring with a sl st. Round 1: 3 ch (counts as first tr), 11 tr into ring. Join with a sl st into 1st tr. [12 sts]

Round 2: 3 ch (counts as 1st tr), [2 ch, 1 tr in next tr] to end. Join with a sl st into 1st tr.

Round 3: sl st into 2 ch sp, 2 ch (counts as part of 1st cluster), tr3tog, 3 ch, [tr4tog, 3 ch, in each ch sp] to end. Sl st into top of 1st cluster. (12 clusters)

Round 4: sl st into 3 ch sp, 2 ch (counts as part of 1st cluster), tr3tog, 3 ch, tr4tog in same ch sp as 1st cluster, 3ch, [tr4tog, 3ch, tr4tog, 3ch, in each ch sp] to end. Sl st into top of 1st cluster. (24 clusters)


Round 5: sl st into 3 ch sp, 2 ch (counts as part of 1st cluster), tr3tog, 3 ch, [tr4tog, 3 ch, in each ch sp] to end. Sl st into top of 1st cluster.

Round 6: 3 ch (counts as 1st tr), 1 tr in same place, 3 tr in next ch sp, [2 tr in next cluster, 3tr in next ch sp] to end. Sl st into 1st tr. (120 sts)

Round 7: 7 ch (counts as 1 tr, 4 ch), miss 3 tr, [1 tr in next tr, 4 ch, miss 3 tr] to end. Sl st into top of 1 st tr. (30 ch spaces)

Round 8: sl st into ch sp, 3 ch (counts as 1st tr), (1 tr, 2 ch, 2 tr) in same ch sp, 3 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp, (4 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp) three times, 3 ch, [(2 tr, 2ch, 2tr) in next ch sp, 3 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp, (4 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp) three times, 3 ch] five times. Sl st into 1st tr.

Round 9: 3 ch (counts as 1st tr), 1 tr in next tr, (1 tr, 2ch, 1 tr) in next ch sp, 1 tr in next 2 tr, 4 ch, miss next ch sp, 1 dc in next ch sp, 3 ch, 3 tr in next ch sp, 3 ch, 1 dc in ch sp, 4 ch, miss next ch sp, [1 tr in next 2 tr, (1 tr, 2ch, 1 tr) in next ch sp, 1 tr in next 2 tr, 4 ch, miss next ch sp, 1 dc in next ch sp, 3 ch, 3 tr in next ch sp, 3 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp, 4 ch, miss next ch sp] five times. Sl st into 1st tr.



Round 10: 3 ch (counts as 1st tr), 1 tr in each of next tr, (1 tr, 2ch, 1 tr) in next ch sp, 1 tr in each of next tr, 3 ch, 1 dc in ch sp, (4 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp) three times, 3 ch, [1 tr in each of next tr, (1 tr, 2ch, 1 tr) in next ch sp, 1 tr in each of next tr, 3 ch, 1 dc in ch sp, (4 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp) three times, 3 ch]. Sl st into 1st tr.

Round 11: 3 ch (counts as 1st tr), 1 tr in each of next tr, (1 tr, 2ch, 1 tr) in next ch sp, 1 tr in each of next tr, 4 ch, miss next ch sp, 1 dc in next ch sp, 3 ch, 3 tr in next ch sp, 3 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp, 4 ch, miss next ch sp, [1 tr in each of next tr, (1 tr, 2ch, 1 tr) in next ch sp, 1 tr in each of next tr, 4 ch, miss next ch sp, 1 dc in next ch sp, 3 ch, 3 tr in next ch sp, 3 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp, 4 ch, miss next ch sp] five times. Sl st into 1st tr.

Rounds 12 - 19: Repeat rounds 10 and 11 four times more. There will be 12 tr added on each round.

Round 20: Repeat round 10 once more.

Round 21: 5 ch (counts as 1st tr and 2 ch), (miss 1 tr, 1 tr in next tr, 2 ch), six times, (1 tr, 3 ch, 1 tr) in ch sp, (2 ch, miss 1 tr, 1 tr in next tr), seven times, miss 1st ch sp, (3 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp, ) 3 times, 3 ch, miss last ch sp, [(miss 1 tr, 1 tr in next tr, 2 ch), seven times, (1 tr, 3 ch, 1 tr) in ch sp, (2 ch, miss 1 tr, 1 tr in next tr), seven times, miss 1st ch sp, (3 ch, 1 dc in next ch sp, ) 3 times, 3 ch, miss last ch sp] five times. Sl st into 1st tr.

Round 22: Sl st into ch sp, 3 ch, sl st in same ch sp, (sl st in next ch sp, 3 ch, sl st in same ch sp) to end, sl st into 1st sl st.

Fasten off and neaten loose ends.

Here is the reworked doily next to the original version.
