
## October Ridge

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Using a simple one row repeat, this reversible infinity scarf is perfect for last minute gifts.

Worked with a provisional cast on and joined at the end with kitchener stitch, you'll be able to wrap yourself in this squishy scarf in a matter of hours!



Using a provisional cast on and scrap yarn, cast on 43 stitches.

Work every row as follows:

(k2,p2) until last stitch, p1

Work until scarf measures 35 inches, or desired length. Graft ends using kitchener stitch. Block if desired, weave in loose ends, wear & enjoy!



## Materials:

l skein Paton's Classic Wool US 7 needles or needle to give gauge scrap yarn sewing needle

## Details:

Gauge: 4 inches = 24 stitches in rib pattern Measurements: 6.5 inches wide



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
