

Knitting pattern by Jennifer Sadler of jaykay knits.



Logan is a simple, chunky, infinity scarf, inspired by reflections in nature. Mine was knit up in just a couple of days, using an extremely soft and warm bulky roving yarn. And, bonus – it's totally reversible!

## Materials:

200 yards of bulky yarn – sample made with Paton's Roving, color Low Tide US 15 circular needles, or needles to give you gauge

## Details:

Gauge: 4 inches = 18 stitches and 14 rows Finished measurements: 7 inches wide and 26 inches long Instructions:

Cast on 126 stitches and join to work in the round. Round 1: K Round 2: P


Repeat rounds 1 & 2 once more, for a total of 4 rounds worked.

Begin round 1 of chart. Chart is worked a total of 7 times each round. Work all 19 rounds of chart.

Work all 19 rounds of chart. Work rounds 1 & 2 twice more for 4 additional rows after row 19 of chart.

Bind off loosely, and block.
