# **TECHNIQUES & ABBREVIATIONS**

**2-colour stranded knitting** - carry the contrast yarn loosely on the wrong side, either weaving it in or stranding it. Do not strand the yarn over more than 3 stitches. I stranded yarn A and caught the contrast yarn once in the middle of each 6 contrast stitches

**K2tog** make a right-leaning decrease by knitting 2 sts together through the front

loops

g grams
yds yards
m metres
in inches
mm millimetres
sts stitches

## SIZES

S, M & L - to 18:20:22in (45:50:56)mm head circumference

#### YARN

Rowan Cocoon

(115m/126yds per 100g ball):

I used yarn from my stash. You can substitute any yarn that has the same yardage as above.

Cocoon: 1 ball each: A (dusty purple), B (teal blue), C (turquoise), D (spring green)

1 ball each E (mustard Missoni) & F (burgundy kettle dyed Araucania)

#### NOTIONS

5mm (US 8), 5.5mm (US 9) needles.

Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

16 sts. and 18 rows = 4in(10cm) over fairisle pattern using 5.5mm needles.

Work swatch and change needles if necessary.

## STITCHES

2 x 2 rib

Stocking stitch

#### TO MAKE

Using smaller needles and A, cast on 72(80:88) sts.

Row 1 k1, \* (p2, k2), repeat from \* across row to last 3 sts, p2, k1

Row 2 p1, \* (k2, p2), repeat from \* across row to last 3 sts, k2, p1

Repeat these 2 rows twice - 6 rows completed.

Change to larger needles and attach yarn B and continue in stocking st as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k6B, k2A), repeat from \* to last 7 sts, k6B, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p6B, k2A) repeat from \* to last 7 sts, p6B, p1A

Repeat these 2 rows twice (6 rows in all), then change Colour B to Colour C, continuing in st st as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k6C, k2A), repeat from \* to last 7 sts, k6C, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p6C, p2A) repeat from \* to last 7 sts, p6C, p1A

Repeat these 2 rows once (4 rows in all), then change Colour C to Colour D, continuing in st St as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k6D, k2A), repeat from \* to last 7 sts, k6D, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p6D, p2A) repeat from \* to last 7 sts, p6D, p1A

Repeat these 2 rows once (4 rows in all), then change Colour D to Colour E, continuing in st st as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k6E, k2A), repeat from \* to last 7 sts, k6E, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p6E, p2A) repeat from \* to last 7 sts, p6E, p1A

Repeat these 2 rows once (4 rows in all), then change Colour E to Colour F, continuing in st St as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k6F, k2A), repeat from \* to last 7 sts, k6F, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p6F, p2A) repeat from \* to last 7 sts, p6F, p1A

Repeat these 2 rows once (4 rows in all), then change Colour F to Colour B, continuing in st St as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k6B, k2A), repeat from \* to last 7 sts, k6B, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p6B, p2A) repeat from \* to last 7 sts, p6B, p1A

Change colour B to Colour C, continuing in st st work as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k2C, k2toqC, k2C, k2A), repeat from \* to last 7 sts, k2C, k2toqC, k2C, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p5C, p2A) repeat from \* to last 6 sts, p5C, p1A

Change colour C to Colour D, continuing in st st work as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k2D, k2togD, k1D, k2A), repeat from \* to last 6 sts, k2D, k2togD, k1D, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p4D, p2A) repeat from \* to last 5 sts, p4D, p1A

Change colour D to Colour E, continuing in st st work as foll:

Row 1 k1A, \*(k2E, k2togE, k2A), repeat from \* to last 5 sts, k2E, k2togE, k1A

Row 2 p1A, \*(p3E, p2A) repeat from \* to last 4 sts, p3E, p1A

Change colour E to Colour F, continuing in st st work as foll:

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Row 1 k1A, *(k1F, k2togF, k2A), repeat from * to last 4 sts, k1F, k2togF, k1A Row 2 p1A, *(p2F, p2A) repeat from * to last 3 sts, p2F, p1A k1A, *(k2togF, k2A), repeat from * to last 3 sts, k2togF, k1A p1A, *(p1F, p2A) repeat from * to last 2 sts, p1F, p1A - 27(30:33) sts Using A only Row 1 k1, *(k2tog, k1), repeat from * to last 4 sts, k2tog p2tog across row – 9(10:11) sts
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Cut yarn leaving a long tail. Thread tapestry needle and run through all stitches, pull tightly together, then fasten off securely.

# FÍNISHING

Press lightly on WS, avoiding rib. Using tapestry needle and A, with RSs together sew seam at centre back of hat. Using A, D and F, make pompom, winding firstly with A until half done, then change to D and wind half of the remaining space, finishing in the centre with F.

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
