

# Ribbon Cluster Lanyard

## **Materials:**

- Size 10 crochet cotton
- Size 4/2.00mm steel crochet hook

**Gauge:** 3 clusters = 1 inch

**Loop:**

Chain 25, in back loop of chain, slip stitch to end. Without twisting the chain, join ends together with slip stitch, chain1, single crochet into loop just made.

**Ribbon:****Step 1:**

Chain 2, yarn over, insert hook into single crochet, yarn over, pull through stitch (3 loops on hook), yarn over, pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over, insert hook into single crochet again, yarn over, pull through stitch (4 loops on hook), yarn over, pull through 2 loops (3 loops on hook). Yarn over, pull through 3 loops. (1 loop on hook) Beginning cluster made.

**Step 2:**

Chain 2, turn, yarn over, insert hook into top of previous cluster, yarn over, pull through stitch (3 loops on hook), yarn over, pull through 2 loops (2 loops on hook), yarn over, insert hook into top of previous cluster again, yarn over, pull through stitch (4 loops on hook), yarn over, pull through 2 loops (3 loops on hook). Yarn over, pull through all 3 loops. (1 loop on hook) Cluster made.

Repeat step 2 until about 30" unstretched or desired length is made, excluding the loop, to be able to go over the head comfortably.

**Finishing:**

Without twisting ribbon, join end into the single crochet of the loop with a slip stitch.

Weave in ends.

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
