Fire on the Wayes

Finished Measurements

Approx. 46" x 58", unblocked

Yarn

Bernat Satin, 100% acrylic, 163 yds (149m) per 100g, 19 skeins of #04111, Denim Mist Heather (The yarn is held doublestranded. It can be substituted with about 1890 yds of a bulky weight yarn.)

Tools

40" US 11 (8mm) circular needle Cable Needle Stitch Markers **Tapestry Needle**

Gauge

12 sts/16 rows = 4"stockinette stitch

Like Bella Swan's luck at First Beach (in New Moon by Stephenie Meyer), this blanket is reversible. The cables are, anyway, and the purl side of the Flame Chevron panels looks like bubbles rushing to the surface. The blanket is knit in one piece, so the panels do not need to be seamed.

Stitch Techniques

K = knit, P = purl

Cable 12 front: Place the next six stitches on the cable needle and hold to the front of the work. Work the following six stitches in pattern, then work the stitches on the cable needle in pattern.

Cable 12 back: Same as above, except hold stitches on the cable needle to the back of the

Decreasing stitches -- SSK (slip, slip, knit) and K2tog (knit two stitches together) Increasing stitches -- YO (yarn over) Sewn Bind Off, optional

Stitch Patterns

Vertical Border 1 x 1 Ribbing

(K1, P1) over the first and last eight stitches of every row, when directed.

Reversible Wave Cables

Multiple of 18 stitches

Row 1: *K1, p1; repeat from * for designated number of stitches in section.

Row 2: Knit the knit stitches, purl the purl stitches to end.

Row 3: Cable 12 front (knitting the knit stitches and purling the purl stitches), *(k1, p1) for six stitches, cable 12 front as before; repeat from * to last six stitches, (k1, p1) the last 6 stitches.

Rows 4-8: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end of section.

Row 9: (K1, p1) for six stitches, cable 12 back (knitting the knit stitches, purling the purl stitches), *(k1, p1) for six stitches, cable 12 back as before; repeat from * to end of section.

Rows 10-12: (K1, p1) to end of section.

Flame Chevron

Two panels of Flame Chevron run down the blanket. Seed stitching flanks the vertical sides of each panel.

Multiple of 7 stitches, plus 16

Row 1 (and all odd-numbered rows): (P1, k1) for six stitches, p18, (p1, k1) last six stitches

Row 2: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k3, *ssk, k5, yo; repeat from * to last 7 stitches of section, k1. (k1. p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 4: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k3, *ssk, k4, yo, k1; repeat from * to last 7 stitches of section, k1, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 6: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k3, *ssk, k3, yo, k2; repeat from * to last 7 stitches of section, k1, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 8: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k3, *ssk, k2, yo, k3; repeat from * to last 7 stitches of section, k1, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 10: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k3, *ssk, k1, yo, k4; repeat from * to last 7 stitches of section, k1, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 12: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k3, *ssk, yo, k5; repeat from * to last 7 stitches of section, k1, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 14: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k1, *yo, k5, k2tog; repeat from * to last 9 stitches, k3, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 16: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k1, *k1, yo, k4, k2tog; repeat from * to last 9 stitches, k3, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 18: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k1, *k2, yo, k3, k2tog; repeat from * to last 9 stitches, k3, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 20: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k1, *k3, yo, k2, k2tog; repeat from * to last 9 stitches, k3, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 22: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k1, *k4, yo, k1, k2tog; repeat from * to last 9 stitches, k3, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Row 24: (K1, p1) for first 6 stitches, k1, *k5, yo, k2tog; repeat from * to last 9 stitches, k3, (k1, p1) last 6 stitches.

Blanket Pattern

Cast on 220 stitches, holding varn double-stranded.

Bottom Border

Rows 1-6: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end

Body of Blanket

- Row 1: 1 x 1 Ribbing border over the first 8 stitches, PM, complete Cable Row 1 over the next 36 stitches, PM, complete Chevron Row 1 over the next 30 stitches, PM, complete Cable Row 1 over the next 72 stitches, PM, complete Chevron Row 1 over the next 30 stitches, PM, complete Cable Row 1 over the next 36 stitches, PM, 1 x 1 Ribbing over the last 8 stitches.
- Row 2: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 2 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 3: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 3 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 4: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 4 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 5: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 5 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 6: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 6 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 7: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 7 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable: 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 8: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 8 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 9: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 9 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 10: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 10 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 11: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 11 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 12: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, complete Row 12 of the stitch patterns in this order: Cable, Chevron, Cable, Chevron, Cable; 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 13: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 1, Chevron Row 13, Cable Row 1, Chevron Row 13, Cable Row 1, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 14: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 2, Chevron Row 14, Cable Row 2, Chevron Row 14, Cable Row 2, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 15: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 3, Chevron Row 15, Cable Row 3, Chevron Row 15, Cable Row 3, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 16: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 4, Chevron Row 16, Cable Row 4, Chevron Row 16, Cable Row 4, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 17: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 5, Chevron Row 17, Cable Row 5, Chevron Row 17, Cable Row 5, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 18: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 6, Chevron Row 18, Cable Row 6, Chevron Row 18, Cable Row 6, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 19: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 7, Chevron Row 19, Cable Row 7, Chevron Row 19, Cable Row 7, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.

- Row 20: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 8, Chevron Row 20, Cable Row 8, Chevron Row 20, Cable Row 8, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 21: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 9, Chevron Row 21, Cable Row 9, Chevron Row 21, Cable Row 9, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 22: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 10, Chevron Row 22, Cable Row 10, Chevron Row 22, Cable Row 10, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 23: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 11, Chevron Row 23, Cable Row 11, Chevron Row 23, Cable Row 11, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Row 24: 1 x 1 Ribbing border, Cable Row 12, Chevron Row 24, Cable Row 12, Chevron Row 24, Cable Row 12, 1 x 1 Ribbing border.
- Repeat Rows 1-24 eight more times, for a total of 9 repeats. Remove markers during Row 24 of final repeat.

Top Border

Rows 1-6: *K1, p1; repeat from * to end.

Finishing

Bind off. (A Sewn Bind Off will closely match the cast on edge, but use whichever bind off method you prefer.) Weave in ends. Block if desired. (The Flame Chevron panels may need blocking more than the cables.)
