

Fuzzy Bottom Shawlette

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This is a winged triangular shawlette with a garter stitch border that is knit from center back to the bottom edge. Yarn overs at each end and along the center stitch are used to form the triangle shape. Increases are worked at the edges on both right and wrong sides and at the center stitch on right side only.

Yarn Requirements:

124 yards (m) of a smooth worsted weight such as Classic Elite Lush in Lipstick (#4458). 40 yards of a textured bulky weight such as Malabrigo 100% Angora in Ravelry Red.

Needles: US size 9 (5.5mm) and US size 11 (8.0 mm) circular 24" long recommended

Additional Materials:

Tapestry needle to weave in ends Stitch markers

Gauge: after blocking

16 sts x 20 rows = 4" in stockinette (Worsted Weight) 10 sts x 12 rows = 4" in garter stitch (Bulky Weight) However, as with most lace, gauge is fairly unimportant.

Finished Size: 38 W x 16 L (blocked)

Notes:

- All rows are worked with two edge stitches in garter stitch.
- In order to increase the size of the stockinette section, work additional repeats
 of rows 3 and 4. In order to increase the size of the garter stitch section, work
 additional repeats of rows 1 and 2. Either will result in an increase of 6 stitches per
 repeat.
- For the k2tog bind off: k2, slip stitches onto left needle, k2tog through the back loop,
 k1, slip stitches onto left needle, k2tog through the back loop, repeat * until all stitches are bound off.

Pattern:

With smooth yarn and smaller (size 9) needles, cast on 7 stitches using long tail cast on. Knit two rows.

Begin stockinette section:

Row 1: k2, yo, k1, yo, place marker, k1, place marker, yo, k1, yo, k2 (11 sts.)

Row 2: k2, yo, p7, yo, k2 (13 sts.)

Row 3: k2, yo, k to first marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, knit to last two stitches, yo, k2

Row 4: k2, yo, purl to last 2 sts, yo, k2

Repeat rows 3 and 4 twenty-three (23) times increasing the number of stitches to a total of 157 stitches.

Attach textured yarn and, using larger (size 11) needles, begin garter stitch section:

Row 1: k2, yo, k to first marker, yo, sm, k1, sm, yo, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2

Row 2: k2, yo, k to first marker, sm, p1, sm, k to last 2 sts, yo, k2

Repeat rows 1 and 2 once more (169 sts at end of section).

Finishing:

Bind off loosely using k2tog bind off. Weave in ends and block.

k= knit p= purl yo= yarn over RS= right side WS= wrong side sm= slip marker sts= stitches
