CABLED HAT FOR HUBBIE



This hat is one size fits most. It is worked from the bottom up.

<u>Yarn Requirements:</u> 140 yards (130m) of sport weight. I used one skein Knit Picks Comfy in Planetarium.

Needles: US size 4 (3.5mm) circular 16" long and US size 4 DPN for top of hat

<u>Additional Materials:</u>

Tapestry needle to weave in ends Stitch markers

Gauge: 22 stitches x 34 rows = 4"(10cm) in ribbing.

Finished Size: 22 inches (56cm) circumference x 7 inches (18cm) long

Notes:

- To increase the circumference of the hat, cast on and work 12 additional stitches. This will Increase the circumference by two (2) inches (5cm).
- To decrease the circumference of the hat, cast on and work 12 fewer stitches. This will decrease the circumference by two (2) inches (5cm).

- To increase the length of the hat work additional rounds of k2, p2 ribbing. Eight (8) additional round will increase the length by one (1) inch (2.5cm). Or work additional repeats of chart A which will increase the length of the hat 1/3 inch (1cm).

Pattern:

Cast on 120 stitches using long tail cast on. Place marker and join in the round taking care not to twist.

Rounds 1-3: * k2, p2 * Repeat * across round.

Work rows 1-3 of chart A three (3) times:




Chart A: Repeat 10 times per round.

Written Pattern:

Round 1: * c2f, p2, (k2, p2) twice *. Repeat * across round. Round 2: * k2, p2, c2f, p2, k2, p2 *. Repeat * across round. Round 3: * (k2, p2) twice, c2f, p2 *. Repeat * across round. Rounds 4-9: Repeat rounds 1-3 twice.

Continue working in k2, p2 rib until the hat measures 5 inches (12.5cm).

Begin decreases (Transfer to double point needles when there are too few stitches to comfortably work on circular needle):

Round 1: * k2, p2 *. Repeat * across round. (120 sts)

Round 2: * (k2, p2) twice, k2, p2tog *. Repeat * across round. (110 sts)

Round 3: * (k2, p2) twice, k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Round 4: * k2, p2, k2, p2tog, k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (100 sts)

Round 5: * k2, p2, (k2, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round.

Round 6: * k2, p2tog, (k2, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round. (90 sts)

Round 7: * k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Round 8: * (k2, p1) twice, ssk, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (80 sts)

Round 9: * (k2, p1) twice, k1, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Round 10: * k2, p1, ssk, p1, k1, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (70 sts)

Round 11: * k2, p1, (k1, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round.

Round 12: * ssk, p1, (k1, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round. (60 sts)

Round 13: * k1, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Round 14: * (k1, p1) twice, ssk *. Repeat * across round. (50 sts)

Round 15: * (k1, p1) twice, k1 *. Repeat * across round.

Round 16: * k1, p1, ssk, k1 *. Repeat * across round. (40 sts)

Round 17: * k1, p1, k2 *. Repeat * across round. Round 18: * ssk, k2 *. Repeat * across round. (30 sts) Round 19: knit all stitches. Round 20: * ssk, k1 *. Repeat * across round. (20 sts) Round 21: * ssk *. Repeat * across round. (10 sts) Round 22: * ssk *. Repeat * across round. (5 sts)

Finishing:

Cut the yarn and thread it through remaining stitches. Then weave in ends and place on the head of the lucky recipient.

c2f= slip 1 stitch onto cable needle and hold in front of project, k1, k stitch from cable needle

Striped Hat for Hubbie



This hat is one size fits most. It is worked from the bottom up.

<u>Yarn Requirements:</u> 70 yards of main color (64m) and 70 yards of contrast color (64m) of sport weight. I used Knit Picks Comfy in Cashew (main color) and Fedora (contrast color).

Needles: US size 4 (3.5mm) circular 16" long and US size 4 DPN for top of hat

Additional Materials:

Tapestry needle to weave in ends Stitch markers

<u>Gauge</u>: 22 stitches x 34 rows = 4" (10cm) in ribbing.

Finished Size: 22 inches (56cm) circumference x 7 inches (18cm) long

Notes:

- To increase the circumference of the hat, cast on and work 12 additional stitches. This will Increase the circumference by two (2) inches (5cm).
- To decrease the circumference of the hat, cast on and work 12 fewer stitches. This will decrease the circumference by two (2) inches (5cm).
- To increase the length of the hat work additional stripes. Each additional stripe will increase the length by 3/4 inch (2cm).

Pattern:

Cast on 120 stitches using long tail cast on using main color (MC). Place marker and join in the round taking care not to twist.

In main color:

Rows 1-6: *k2, p2*. Repeat * across round.

Attach contrast color:

Row 7: knit all stitches.

Rows 8-12: *k2, p2*. Repeat * across round.

Attach main color:

Repeat rows 7-12.

Work rows 1-12 twice, more alternating stripes as indicated previously, to increase length. The hat should measure 5 inches (12.5cm).

Begin decreases (Transfer to double point needles when there are too few stitches to comfortably work on circular needle):

Attach contrast color:

Row 1: knit all stitches.

Row 2: * (k2, p2) twice, k2, p2tog *. Repeat * across round. (110 sts)

Row 3: * (k2, p2) twice, k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Row 4: * k2, p2, k2, p2tog, k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (100 sts)

Row 5: * k2, p2, (k2, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round.

Row 6: * k2, p2tog, (k2, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round. (90 sts)

Attach main color:

Row 7: knit all stitches.

Row 8: * (k2, p1) twice, ssk, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (80 sts)

Row 9: * (k2, p1) twice, k1, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Row 10: * k2, p1, ssk, p1, k1, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (70 sts)

Row 11: * k2, p1, (k1, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round.

Row 12: * ssk, p1, (k1, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round. (60 sts)

Attach contrast color:

Row 13: knit all stitches.

Row 14: * (k1, p1) twice, ssk *. Repeat * across round. (50 sts)

Row 15: * (k1, p1) twice, k1 *. Repeat * across round.

Row 16: * k1, p1, ssk, k1 *. Repeat * across round. (40 sts)

Row 17: * k1, p1, k2 *. Repeat * across round.

Row 18: * ssk, k2 *. Repeat * across round. (30 sts)

Attach main color:

Row 19: knit all stitches.

Row 20: * ssk, k1 *. Repeat *. across round. (20 sts)

Row 21: * ssk * Repeat *. across round. (10 sts)

Row 22: * ssk * Repeat *. across round. (5 sts)


Finishing:

Cut the yarn and thread it through remaining stitches. Then weave in ends and place on the head of the lucky recipient.

Legend:

k= knit
p= purl
p2tog= purl 2 stitches together
ssk= slip, slip, knit slipped stitches together
(stitches should be slipped knitwise)
sts= stitches

Striped Hat for Hubbie too



This hat is one size fits most. It is worked from the bottom up.

<u>Yarn Requirements:</u> 100 yards (91m) of main color and 40 yards contrast color (37m) of sport weight. I used Knit Picks Comfy in Planetarium for main color and Misti Alpaca Pima Cotton and Silk in Excalibur for contrast color.

Needles: US size 4 (3.5mm) circular 16" long and US size 4 DPN for top of hat

Additional Materials:

Tapestry needle to weave in ends Stitch markers

Gauge: 22 stitches x 34 rows = 4" (10cm) in ribbing.

Finished Size: 22 inches (56cm) circumference x 7 inches (18cm) long

Notes:

- To increase the circumference of the hat, cast on and work 12 additional stitches. This will Increase the circumference by two (2) inches (5cm).
- To decrease the circumference of the hat, cast on and work 12 fewer stitches. This will decrease the circumference by two (2) inches (5cm).
- To increase the length of the hat work additional stripes. Each additional stripe will increase the length by 3/4 inch (2cm).

Pattern:

Cast on 120 stitches using long tail cast on using main color. Place marker and join in the round taking care not to twist.

In main color:

Rows 1-6: *k2, p2* Repeat * across round.

Attach contrast color:

Row 7: knit all stitches.

Rows 8-12: *k2, p2* Repeat * across round.

Attach main color:

Repeat rows 7-12.

Attach contrast color:

Repeat rows 7-12.

Attach main color:

Knit one round. Then continue working in k2, p2 rib until the hat measures 5 inches (12.5cm).

Begin decreases (Transfer to double point needles when there are too few stitches to comfortably work on circular needle):

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Round 1: * k2, p2 *. Repeat * across round. (120 sts)
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Round 2: * (k2, p2) twice, k2, p2tog *. Repeat * across round. (110 sts)

Round 3: * (k2, p2) twice, k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Round 4: * k2, p2, k2, p2tog, k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (100 sts)

Round 5: * k2, p2, (k2, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round.

Round 6: * k2, p2tog, (k2, p1) twice *. Repeat * across round. (90 sts)

Round 7: * k2, p1 *. Repeat * across round.

Round 8: * (k2, p1) twice, ssk, p1 *. Repeat * across round. (80 sts)

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Round 21: * ssk *. Repeat * across round. (10 sts)

Round 22: * ssk *. Repeat * across round. (5 sts)

Finishing:

Cut the yarn and thread it through remaining stitches. Then weave in ends and place on the head of the lucky recipient.

Legend:

k= knit
p= purl
p2tog= purl 2 stitches together
ssk= slip, slip, knit slipped stitches together
(stitches should be slipped knitwise)
sts= stitches

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
