

Camping Shawl

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This is a triangular shawlette worked from side to side in garter stitch. Increases and decreases along one side are used to form the triangle shape. Increases are worked on right side only. Decreases are worked on wrong side only. This pattern includes two sizes: shawlette (shawl).

Yarn Requirements:

Shawlette: 440 yards (m) of fingering weight. Shawl: 650 yards (m) of fingering to sport weight.

Needles:

Shawlette: US size 5 (3.75mm) circular 24" long recommended Shawl: US size 7 (4.5mm) circular 24" long recommended

Additional Materials:

Tapestry needle to weave in ends Stitch markers

Gauge: (unblocked)

Shawlette: 24 sts x 32 rows = 4" in garter stitch Shawl: 20 sts x 24 rows = 4" in garter stitch Finished Size: (unblocked)

Shawlette: 62 inches W x 12 inches L Shawl: 80 inches W x 15 inches L

Notes:

- The number before the parentheses is for the shawlette version. The number in parentheses is for the shawl version.

Pattern:

Cast on 3 stitches using long tail cast on. Knit one row.

Begin increases (worked on right side of fabric):

Row 1: \$1, K1, M1, knit to end of row.

Row 2: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Repeat rows 1-2 thirty (thirty) times. 33 stitches at end of section.

Row 1: \$1, K1, M1, knit to end of row.

Row 2-4: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Repeat rows 1-4 twenty (twenty) times. 53 stitches at end of section.

Row 1: \$1, K1, M1, knit to end of row.

Row 2-6: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Repeat rows 1-6 fourteen (fourteen) times. 67 stitches at end of section.

Row 1: \$1, K1, M1, knit to end of row.

Row 2-8: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Repeat rows 1-8 two (ten) times. 69 (77) stitches at end of section.

Row 1: \$1, K1, M1, knit to end of row.

Row 2-10: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Repeat rows 1-10 zero (two) times. 69 (79) stitches at end of section.

Begin decreases (worked on wrong side of fabric):

Row 1-9: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Row 10: \$1, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Repeat rows 1-10 zero (two) times. (69) 77 stitches at end of section.

Row 1-7: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Row 8: \$1, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Repeat rows 1-8 two (ten) times. 67 stitches at end of section.

Row 1-5: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Row 6: \$1, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Repeat rows 1-6 fourteen (fourteen) times. 53 stitches at end of section.

Row 1-3: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Row 4: \$1, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Repeat rows 1-4 twenty (twenty) times. 33 stitches at end of section.

Row 1: \$1, knit remaining stitches.

Row 2: \$1, knit to last three stitches, k2tog, k1.

Repeat rows 1-2 thirty (thirty) times. 3 stitches at end of section.

<u>Finishing:</u> Knit one row. Bind off remaining stitches. Weave in ends. Block if desired.

Legend:

k= knit k2tog= knit 2 stitches together M1= make one stitch using backward loop S1= slip one stitch purlwise from left to right needle sts= stitches
