CANDY CORN MITTENS

alloween is one of my favorite holidays of the year! While I know October in Florida is definitely nowhere near cold or chilly, I could not resist knitting a pair of mittens to celebrate the coming Fall season. Like traditional candy corn, these mittens are knitted with a short section of yellow, a long orange middle, and a creamy white top. In researching Candy Corn I found there are other types too! You can have candy corn all year round!!!

- Indian Corn White, Orange, Brown
- Reindeer Corn White, Green, Red
- · Cupid Corn White, Pink, Red
- Easter Bunny Corn White & Pastels

Yarn - Cascade 220 Yarn White #8505 Blaze (Orange) #9542 Neon Yellow #7828

Needles:

16" - US 8 circular 5" - Set of (5) US 7 DPNs

Other:

Tapestry Needle Row Counter Waste Yarn

K - Knit

P - Purl

PM - Place Marker

RM - Remove Marker

SKPO - Slip, Knit, Pass slip stitch over as if to bind off

Sts - Stitches

Cuff

(Long Tail) Cast On 40 Stitches on US 8 circular with **NEON YELLOW**. Carefully transfer sts evenly onto 4 DPNs and join in the round, being careful not to twist the foundation row.

Note: I like the Long Tail Cast On as the tail will always show me where my row begins.

Rows

01-12: K1, P1

13-18: Knit (aka 6 rows)

Thumb Gusset - Right

19: K18, PM, K4, M1F, PM, Knit to end of round

20: Knit

21: K18, PM, K5, M1F, PM, Knit to end of round

22: Knit

23: K18, PM, K6, M1F, PM, Knit to end of round

24: Knit

25: K18, PM, K7, M1F, PM, Knit to end of round

26: Knit

27: K18, PM, K8, M1F, PM, Knit to end of round

28: Change to **ORANGE**, Knit

29: K18, PM, K9, M1F, PM, Knit to end of round

30: Knit

31: K18, PM, K10, M1F, PM, Knit to end of round

33: K18, RM, Using tapestry needle w/waste yarn, place 11 gusset stitches onto waste yarn and secure, RM, *M1A - 4 times over gusset opening*, Knit remaining stitches

Thumb Gusset - Left

19: K18, PM, M1F, K4, PM, Knit to end of round

20: Knit

21: K18, PM, M1F, K5, PM, Knit to end of round

22: Knit

23: K18, PM, M1F, K6, PM, Knit to end of round

24: Knit

25: K18, PM, M1F, K7, PM, Knit to end of round

26: Knit

27: K18, PM, M1F, K8, PM, Knit to end of round

28: Change to **ORANGE**, Knit

29: K18, PM, M1F, K9, PM, Knit to end of round

30: Knit

31: K18, PM, M1F, K10, PM, Knit to end of round

33: K18, RM, Using tapestry needle w/waste yarn, place 11 gusset stitches onto waste yarn and secure, RM, *M1A - 4 times over gusset opening*, Knit remaining stitches

Palm of Mitten

34-51: Knit (aka 18 rows)

On final row, leave 12" of orange yarn and cut

Top of Mitten

52: Change to WHITE, Knit

53-57: Knit (aka 5 rows)

58:* K1, SKPO, Knit to the last three stitches on Second Needle, K2TOG, K1*. Repeat directions for needles 3 & 4. (36 Stitches)



59: *K1, SKPO, Knit to the last three stitches on Second Needle, K2TOG, K1*. Repeat directions for needles 3 & 4. (32 Stitches)

60: *K1, SKPO, Knit to the last three stitches on Second Needle, K2TOG, K1*. Repeat directions for needles 3 & 4. (28 Stitches)

61: *K1, SKPO, Knit to the last three stitches on Second Needle, K2TOG, K1*. Repeat directions for needles 3 & 4. (24 Stitches)

62: *K1, SKPO, Knit to the last three stitches on Second Needle, K2TOG, K1*. Repeat directions for needles 3 & 4. (20 Stitches)

Combine needles 1 & 2 onto one DPN, combine needles 3 & 4 onto a second DPN. Leave 18" of white yarn and cut. Graft top of mitten using the Kitchener Stitch.

Thumb

63: Slide the 11 stitches from the waste yarn onto three needles (5 - 5 - 1). Using ORANGE yarn pickup 9 stitches(4 on needle three, five on needle 4) over the topside of the thumb gusset. (20 stitches) Join in the round.

64-75: Knit (aka 12 rows)

76: *K1, K2TOG, K1, K1* (16 Stitches)

77: Knit

78: *K1, K2TOG, K1* (12 Stitches)

79: Knit

80: *K1, K2TOG* (8 Stitches)

Leave at least 12" of orange yarn to work with and place tapestry needle on the yarn. Slip remaining 8 stitches onto tapestry needle, draw in tight, and poke through the center of the circle. Weave in yarn end.
