

FELTED MINIBAG FOR KNITTING FRAMES

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REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. 1 skein Lion Brand Landscapes yarn
- 2. Red Knifty Knitter or similar frame
- 3. Washer and dryer

KNIT THE BAG:

- 1. Cast on by e-wrapping twice around the frame, then knitting every stitch, (basic cast on)
- 2. Knit 24 rounds with the e-wrap stitch. This is the body of the bag
- 3. Bind off 15 stitches.
- 4. Knit back and forth on the remaining 16 stitches for 16 rows. (photo)
- 5. Bind off. (Last 16 rows have formed the flap of the bag)
- 6. Sew cast on together to form bottom of bag. Make sure to flatten the bag before sewing the seam to be certain that flap will fall correctly

FELT THE BAG:

- 1. Run through the washing machine with other items. A front load washer and warm or hot water is preferred
- 2. Get the bag wetter and run through dryer for 30-40 minutes
- 3. When fabric is very tight, felting is complete. Air dry the rest of the way. This yarn is only half wool so the stitches will not entirely disappear

FINISH:

- 1. Trim yarn ends. After felting, they will not run or ravel. Also, edges won't roll.
- 2. Add a strap, a snap or a belt hanger
- 3. Tuck in your essentials! Bag is about 5"x6"
