

## FUNNY BEAR CROCHET PATTERN



**Used material:** wool – red (one ball), black (not much – just for the muzzle) - (we used Czech production wool with parameter 50g/152 m -name: Elian Nicky, VSV Pilníkov, it is 100 % acryl),

Toy stuffing material (e.g. PES balls)

Thread to sew the parts together

Safety eyes – black 10 mm (you can get them easily on internet)

Small piece of white felt under the safety eyes – as eye white)

We work with single crochet (SC), use slip stitch (Sl St) to join the rows. Start each row with two chain stitches (Ch) – (do not count the chain stitches into the total count of stitches) – and finish each row with slip stitch.

### Terminology:

SC = single crochet

DC = double crochet

Ch = chain

DEC = decrease

### Head and body: red color

*Note: at first you will not be probably sure about the shape of the head and body, which will come out. The head is way too large for the body. However, when you sew on the ears and the nose it will be much better. When you add the hands and legs, you will like it. Do not give up! It is worth the work :-)*

Start with the loop

**1<sup>st</sup> row** – crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 6 SC into the loop.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row** – crochet two SC into each SC of the first row, repeat 6x =12 SC in total

**3<sup>rd</sup> row** – crochet one SC into the first SC of the second row, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total

**4<sup>th</sup> row** – one SC into the first two SC of the last row, 2 SC into the third SC, repeat 6x =24 SC in total



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5<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first three SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fourth SC, repeat 6x =30 SC in total

6<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first four SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fifth SC, repeat 6x =36 SC in total

7<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first five SC of the last row, 2 SC into the sixth SC, repeat 6x =42 SC in total

8<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first six SC, 2 SC into the seventh SC, repeat 6x =48 SC in total

9<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first seven SC, 2 SC into the eighth SC, repeat 6x =54 SC in total

10<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first eight SC, 2 SC into the ninth SC, repeat 6x =60 SC in total

11<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 60 SC in total

12<sup>th</sup> – 25<sup>th</sup> row – the same as the 11<sup>th</sup> row (14 rows, 60 SC in total in each row)

26<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first eight SC, DEC (crochet together the 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> – or skip 9<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =54 SC in total

27<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 54 SC in total

28<sup>th</sup> row – the same as the 27<sup>th</sup> row (54 SC in total)

29<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first seven SC, DEC (crochet together the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> – or skip 8<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =48 SC in total

30<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 48 SC in total

31<sup>st</sup> row – the same as the 30<sup>th</sup> row (48 SC in total)

32<sup>nd</sup> row – one SC into the first six SC, DEC (crochet together the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> – or skip 7<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =42 SC in total

33<sup>rd</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 42 SC in total

34<sup>th</sup> row – the same as the 33<sup>rd</sup> row (42 SC in total)

35<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first five SC, DEC (crochet together the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> – or skip 6<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =36 SC in total

36<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 36 SC in total

37<sup>th</sup> row – the same as the 36<sup>th</sup> row (36 SC in total)

38<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first four SC, DEC (crochet together the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> – or skip 5<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =30 SC in total

39<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 30 SC in total

40<sup>th</sup> row – the same as the 39<sup>th</sup> row (30 SC in total)

41<sup>st</sup> row – one SC into the first three SC, DEC (crochet together the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> – or skip 4<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =24 SC in total

42<sup>nd</sup> row – one SC into the first three SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fourth SC, repeat 6x =30 SC in total

43<sup>rd</sup> row – one SC into the first four SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fifth SC, repeat 6x =36 SC in total

44<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 36 SC in total

45<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first five SC of the last row, 2 SC into the sixth SC, repeat 6x =42 SC in total

46<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 42 SC in total

47<sup>th</sup> – 55<sup>th</sup> row – the same as the 46<sup>th</sup> row (9 rows, 42 SC in total in each row)

56<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first five SC, DEC (crochet together the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> – or skip 6<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =36 SC in total

57<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first four SC, DEC (crochet together the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> – or skip 5<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =30 SC in total

58<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first three SC, DEC (crochet together the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> – or skip 4<sup>th</sup>), repeat 6x =24 SC in total

Interrupt the work. Cut small rounds from the white felt for the eye white (make sure the eye white is not too large, it should be just a little larger than the diameter of the eye so it would not stick out under the eye; the eye white holds on head just thanks to the eye, you do not sew it on), make a small whole in the middle of the white felt, put the safety eye through it and place it on head as you can see on the picture and secure. Than fill the head and body in with the toy stuffing and continue as follows:

59<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first two SC, DEC (crochet together the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> – or skip 3<sup>rd</sup>), repeat 6x =18 SC in total

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**60<sup>th</sup> row** – one SC into the first SC, DEC (crochet together the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> – or skip 2<sup>nd</sup>), repeat 6x =12 SC in total

**61<sup>st</sup> row** – DEC (crochet together the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> – or skip 1<sup>st</sup>), repeat 6x =6 SC in total

**62<sup>nd</sup> row** – DEC (crochet together the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> – or skip 1<sup>st</sup>), repeat 3x =3 SC in total, Fasten off

## Ears (make 2): red color

Start with the loop

**1<sup>st</sup> row** – crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 6 SC into the loop.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row** – crochet two SC into each SC of the first row, repeat 6x =12 SC in total

**3<sup>rd</sup> row** – crochet one SC into the first SC of the second row, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total

**4<sup>th</sup> row** – one SC into the first two SC of the last row, 2 SC into the third SC, repeat 6x =24 SC in total

**5<sup>th</sup> row** – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 24 SC in total

**6<sup>th</sup> – 12<sup>th</sup> row** – the same as the 5<sup>th</sup> row (7 rows, 24 SC in total in each row)



## Legs (make 2): red color

Start with 7 + 2 Ch.

**1<sup>st</sup> row** – crochet according the scheme on right (crochet 9 Ch, starting from the third Ch from the hook, crochet 6 SC – one into each Ch, than three into the last one, turn the work and crochet from the other side one SC into each Ch (5 times), than 2 SC into the last Ch = 16 SC in total

**2<sup>nd</sup> row** – crochet one SC into each of the first seven SC of the first row. Make 3 SC into the 8<sup>th</sup> SC, than crochet one SC into each of the next 7 SC and 3 SC into the last SC = 20 SC in total

**3<sup>rd</sup> row** – crochet 2 SC into the first SC of the last row, than one SC into each of next 5 SC, crochet 2 SC into each of following 5 SC, than again one SC into each of next 5 SC and 2 SC into each of last 4 SC = 30 SC in total

**4<sup>th</sup> row** – crochet one SC into each SC of last row = 30 SC in total

**5<sup>th</sup> row** – crochet one SC into each SC of last row = 30 SC in total

**6<sup>th</sup> row** – the same as the 5<sup>th</sup> row (30 SC in total)

**7<sup>th</sup> row** – crochet 1 SC into first five SC, **\*DEC – crochet together the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> SC - or skip 6<sup>th</sup>, than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.\***, repeat between\* \* 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total), SC one into each of remaining ten SC = 25 SC in total

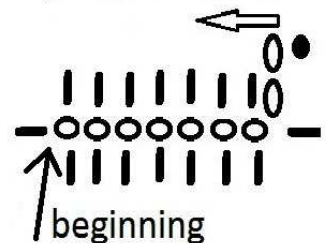
**8<sup>th</sup> row** – crochet 1 SC into first three SC, **\*DEC – crochet together the 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> SC - or skip 4<sup>th</sup>, than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.\***, repeat between\* \* 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total), SC one into each of remaining seven SC = 20 SC in total

**9<sup>th</sup> row** – crochet 1 SC into first SC, **\*DEC – crochet together the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> SC - or skip 2<sup>nd</sup>, than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.\***, repeat between\* \* 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total), SC one into each of remaining four SC = 15 SC in total

**10<sup>th</sup> row** – **\*DEC – crochet together the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> SC - or skip 1<sup>st</sup>, than crochet 1 SC into the next SC.\***, repeat between\* \* 4 more times (so you make it 5 times in total)= 10 SC in total



- ! - Single Crochet (SC)
- o - Chain (Ch)
- - Slip Stitch (Sl St)



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Interrupt the work and fill in the leg with toy stuffing, than continue work as follows

11<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the tenth row = 10 SC in total

12<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> row – the same as 11<sup>th</sup> row (9 rows, 10 SC in total in each row), Fasten off

## Hands (make 2): red color

Start with the loop

1<sup>st</sup> row – crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 6 SC into the loop

2<sup>nd</sup> row – in each SC of the first row crochet two, repeat 6x =12 SC in total

3<sup>rd</sup> row – crochet one SC into the first SC, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total

4<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 18 SC in total

5<sup>th</sup> row – the same as 5<sup>th</sup> row (18 SC in total)

Interrupt the work and fill in the hand with toy stuffing, than continue work as follows:

6<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC, DEC (crochet together the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> SC – or skip 2<sup>nd</sup> ), repeat 6 x = 12 SC in total

7<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 12 SC in total

8<sup>th</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup> row –the same as 7<sup>th</sup> row (3 rows, 12 SC in total in each row)

11<sup>th</sup> row – crochet two SC, DEC (crochet together the 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> SC – or skip 3<sup>rd</sup> ), repeat 3 x = 9 SC in total

12<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 9 SC in total

13<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> row – the same as 12<sup>th</sup> row (9 rows, 9 SC in total in each row)



## Muzzle: black color

Start with the loop

1<sup>st</sup> row – crochet 2 Ch (as each beginning) and 6 SC into the loop

2<sup>nd</sup> row – in each SC of the first row crochet two, repeat 6x =12 SC in total

3<sup>rd</sup> row – crochet one SC into the first SC, crochet 2 SC into the second SC, repeat 6x =18 SC in total

4<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first two SC of the last row, 2 SC into the third SC, repeat 6x =24 SC in total

5<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first three SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fourth SC, repeat 6x =30 SC in total

6<sup>th</sup> row – one SC into the first four SC of the last row, 2 SC into the fifth SC, repeat 6x =36 SC in total

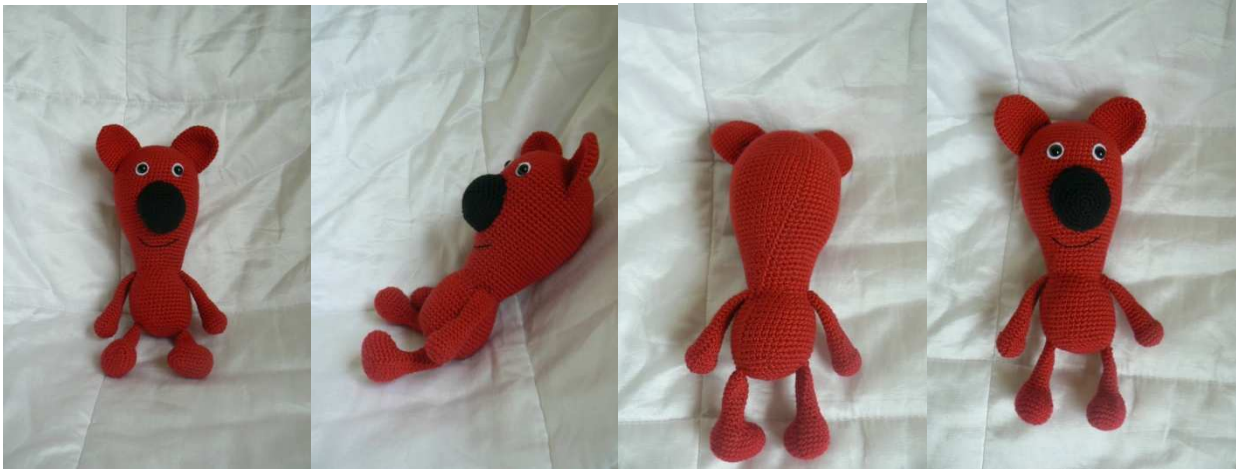
7<sup>th</sup> row – crochet one SC into each SC of the last row = 36 SC in total

8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> row – same as the 7<sup>th</sup> row (2 SC in total in each row)



Before you sew the muzzle on head make sure you add some toy stuffing underneath. Sew legs and hands to the body and embroider mouth using black color thread. You are done! Have fun with the Funny Bear pattern:-)

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
