## BRAIDED HAT

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## Skill level

Intermediate

## You need

YARN: Super
Bulky weight yarn; shown in DROPS Andes
(65\% Wool, 35\%
Alpaca, 109yds / 100m, 3.53oz / 100 g ) in color 3740, 2 balls NEEDLES: US 10 [6mm] straight needles NOTIONS: cable needle, tapestry needle, crochet
hook for attaching fringe

## Gauge

14 sts $/ 18$ rows $=4$ " / 10cm over crown pattern

## Size

One size (will comfortably fit head circumference 21 12-22 $1 / 21 / 55-57 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Finished measurements

Circumference: $221 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} / 57 \mathrm{~cm}$
Height: $71 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} / 19 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Abbreviations

C6B - (cable 6 back) slip 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, k3 from left-hand needle, then k3 from cable needle C6F - (cable 6 front) slip 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, k3 from left-hand needle, then $k 3$ from cable needle
CO - cast on
k-knit
k2tog - knit 2 sts together
m1k - (make one knit) with left needle, lift strand between needles, from back to front and knit lifted loop
m1p - (make one purl) with left needle, lift strand between needles, from back to front and purl lifted loop
p2tog - purl 2 sts together
p-purl
pwise - purlwise
RS - right side
sl - slip
ssk - slip, slip, knit slipped sts together through back loops
st(s) - stitch(es)
WS - wrong side
wyif - with yarn in front

## Notes

$\mathbf{1}$ The hat is worked back and forth in rows. Then sts are picked up and worked for forehead and back of head.
$\mathbf{2}$ Cable needle is optional, because there are not that many stitches to rearrange (just let the stitches off the needle and pick them up again in the right order and then knit them).
3 Remember to sl $1^{\text {st }}$ st of every row pwise wyif and k last st of every row.

## DIRECTIONS

## BEGINNING OF BRAID

CO 5 sts, leaving a $8^{\prime \prime}(20.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail.
Foundation row (WS): K1, p3, k1. 5 sts.
Work from Chart A (once) or follow written directions.

Row 1 (RS): SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, m1k) twice, k2. 7 sts.
Row 2: SI1 pwise wyif, p to last st, k1.
Row 3: SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, m1k) 4 times, k2. 11 sts.
Row 4: As row 2.

## FIRST BRAID

Work from Chart B (repeat rows 1-8 four times, then rows 1-4 once more) or follow written directions.

Row 1 (RS): Sl1 pwise wyif, k3, C6F, k1.
Row 2: SI1 pwise wyif, p to last st, k1.
Row 3: SI1 pwise wyif, $k$ to end.

Row 4: As row 2.
Row 5: SI1 pwise wyif, C6B, k4.
Row 6: As row 2.
Row 7: As row 3.
Row 8: As row 2.
Repeat rows 1-8 three more times, then rows 1-4 once more.

## FIRST SIDE OF HAT

Work from Chart C (once) or follow written directions.

Row 1 (RS): Sl1 pwise wyif, (k1, m1p) 8 times, k2. 19 sts.
Row 2: SI1 pwise wyif, (p1, k1) 9 times.
Row 3: SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, p1) 8 times, k2.
Row 4: As row 2.
Row 5: SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, m1p, p1) 8 times, k2. 27 sts.
Row 6: SI1 pwise wyif, (p1, k2) 8 times, p1, k1.
Row 7: SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, p2) 8 times, k2.
Row 8: As row 6.
Row 9: SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, p2, m1p) 8 times, k2. 35 sts.
Row 10: SI1 pwise wyif, (p1, k3) 8 times, p1, k1.

## CROWN OF HAT

Work from Chart D (repeat rows 1 and 2 twenty times) or follow written directions.

Row 1 (RS): SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, p3) 8 times, k2.
Row 2: SI1 pwise wyif, (p1, k3) 8 times, p1, k1.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 nineteen more times.

## SECOND SIDE OF HAT

Work from Chart E (once) or follow written directions.

Row 1 (RS): SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, p1, p2tog) 8 times, k2. 27 sts.
Row 2: SI1 pwise wyif, (p1, k2) 8 times, p1, k1.
Row 3: Sl1 pwise wyif, (k1, p2) 8 times, k2.
Row 4: As row 2.
Row 5: SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, p2tog) 8 times, k2. 19 sts.
Row 6: SI1 pwise wyif, (p1, k1) 9 times.
Row 7: SI1 pwise wyif, (k1, p1) 8 times, k2.
Row 8: As row 6.
Row 9: SI1 pwise wyif, (ssk) 8 times, k2. 11 sts.
Row 10: SI1 pwise wyif, p to last st, k1.

## SECOND BRAID

Work from Chart F (repeat rows 1-8 four times, then rows 1-4 once more) or follow written directions.

Row 1 (RS) Sl1 pwise wyif, $k$ to end.
Row 2: Sl1 pwise wyif, p to last st, k1.

Row 3: SI1 pwise wyif, k3, C6B, k1.
Row 4: As row 2.
Row 5: As row 1.
Row 6: As row 2.
Row 7: SI1 pwise wyif, C6F, k4.
Row 8: As row 2.
Repeat rows 1-8 three more times, then rows 1-4 once more.

## END OF BRAID

Work from Chart G (once) or follow written directions.

Row 1 (RS): SI1 pwise wyif, (ssk) 4 times, k2. 7 sts.
Row 2: Sl1 pwise wyif, (p2tog) twice, p1, k1. 5 sts.

Last row (RS): Cast off all sts, leaving a $8^{\prime \prime}(20.5 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail.

## FRONT OF THE HAT

Left side of the hat.
With RS facing pick up and knit 18 center sts from the side edge (selvage sts), plus one more st, turn. 19 sts.
Row 1 (WS): (P1, k1) 9 times, p1, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 20 sts.
Row 2: K1, (k1, p1) 9 times, k1, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 21 sts.
Row 3: P1, (p1, k1) 10 times, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 22 sts.
Row 4: (K1, p1) 11 times, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 23 sts.
Row 5: ( $\mathrm{P} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ ) 11 times, p1, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 24 sts.
Row 6: K1, (k1, p1) 11 times, k1, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 25 sts.
Row 7: P1, (p1, k1) 12 times, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 26 sts.
Row 8: (K1, p1) 13 times, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 27 sts.
Row 9: (P1, k1) 13 times, p1, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 28 sts.
Row 10 (RS): Cast off sts in rib (at the beginning of row sl $1^{\text {st }}$ st pwise wyib and at the end of row pick up and knit 1 st from side edge).

## BACK OF THE HAT

Right side of the hat.
With RS facing pick up and knit 18 center sts from the side edge (selvage sts), plus one more st, turn. 19 sts.
Row 1 (WS): (P1, k1) 9 times, p1, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 20 sts.
Row 2: K1, (k1, p1) 9 times, k1, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 21 sts.

Row 3: P1, (p1, k1) 10 times, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 22 sts.
Row 4: (K1, p1) 11 times, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 23 sts.
Row 5: (P1, k1) 11 times, p1, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 24 sts.
Row 6: K1, (k1, p1) 11 times, k1, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 25 sts.
Row 7: P1, (p1, k1) 12 times, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 26 sts.
Row 8: (K1, p1) 13 times, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 27 sts.
Row 9: (P1, k1) 13 times, p1, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 28 sts.
Row 10: K1, (k1, p1) 13 times, k1, pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, turn. 29 sts.
Row 11: P1, (p1, k1) 14 times, pick up and purl 1 st from side edge, turn. 30 sts.
Row 12 (RS): Cast off sts in rib (k2tog all sts before casting off; at the beginning of row sl $1^{\text {st }}$ st pwise wyib and at the end of row pick up and knit 1 st from side edge, do not include these sts in k2tog).

FINISHING

Weave in ends, but don't cut them off yet. Wash and block the hat.

With yarn end left at the beginning of the first braid, join the ends of cast on edge. With yarn end left at the end of the second braid, join the ends of cast off edge.


Cut 14 pieces of yarn into 15 -inch ( 38 cm ) lengths ( 7 pieces for each braid).
Hold 7 lengths of yarn together and fold them in half. With a crochet hook pull the middle of the foldedup lengths of yarn from front to back through the hole at the end of the first braid.


Pull loose ends trough loop and pull to secure. Neaten the ends of fringe.



Do the same with other 7 lengths of yarn and make a fringe at the end of the second braid.
Cut the yarn ends.
