## Hookey Gloves

## Materials:

Yarn: 1 skein Blue Sky Alpaca Sportweight (110 yds)
Needles: US 4's, both circular and DPN's (or just DPN's if you don't like magic loop)
Gauge: 12 sts x 19 rows

## Techniques:

-Magic Loop
$-5 C R$ (5 stitch cable to the right): hold 2 knit sts to front, next 3 sts: K2 P1, K2 sts from holder
-5CL (5 stitch cable to the left): hold 2 knit sts to back, next 3 sts: K2 P1, K2 sts from holder


## Pattern:

CO 45 sts using long tail method.
Rounds 1-8: K1, P1, *K2, P1,* end with K1
Round 9: K1, P1, K2, row 1 of chart, K2, P1, K22
Continue as round 9 for 2 full repeats of chart.


Start thumb gusset:
Round 1: M1, K1, P1, K2, continue chart, K2, P1, K22, M1
Round 2: K2, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K23
Round 3: K1, M1, K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22, M1, K1
Round 4: K3, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K24
Round 5: K2, M1, K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22, M1, K2
Round 6: K4, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K25
Round 7: K3, M1, K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22, M1, K3
Round 8: K5, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K26
Round 9: K4, M1, K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22, M1, K4

Round 10: K6, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K27
Round 11: K5, M1, K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22, M1, K5
Round 12: K7, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K28
Round 13: K6, M1, K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22, M1, K6
Round 14: K8, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K29
Round 15: K7, M1, K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22-
Transfer next 7 stitches of round and first 8 stitches of next round to waste yarn.
To finish finger opening:
K1, P1, K2, chart, K2, P1, K22
Join in round and continue in pattern for 1.5 repeats.
Switch to K2 P1 ribbing for 8 rounds.

BO loosely.
To finish thumb:
Transfer 15 sts from waste yarn to DPN's. (5 sts each on 3 needles).
Pick up 3 stitches on top of thumb with $4^{\text {th }}$ needle.


Knit in stockinette for 3 rows.
Switch to K2 P1 ribbing for 5 rows. BO loosely.

Repeat all for second glove, transferring the thumb gusset to the other side.
Weave in all ends and block.

Notes: The chart stitch pattern is derived from the " 5 -Rib Braid" found in Claire Crompton's The Knitter's Bible.
