

Bubbly Sea Shell Scarf



I swatched an edging pattern named Sea Shell Lace edging I found from an old lace knitting book published in 1884. Then I charted the pattern and got an idea that with a little modifying it would be a perfect pattern for a beautiful little scarf. There are no wrong or right side of this pattern, so both sides look similar.

Info

Size shown: length 72 cm, width 23 cm without stretching

Yarn suggestion: aran weight fluffy mohair, wool or blend yarn (e.g. acrylic-mohair blend)

Gauge: 15 - 16 sts and 21 rows = 10 cm / 4 inches in stockinette stitch, isn't critical

Needles: US 8 - 10 / 5 - 6 mm or suitable for your yarn

Yardage: approx. 220 meters (240 yards), depends a lot on your yarn and needle choice

Yarn weight, gauge and needle size are only suggestions, so feel free to make a choice of your own. The dark green scarf pictured is made of 100 grams Rondo Lilie yarn (110 meters per 50 grams, 20 % mohair and 80 % acrylic) and with US 8 / 5 mm needles.

Chart key

I	knit
-	purl
OO	double yarn over (k1, p1 on the next row)
O	yarn over
S	purl 2 stitches together
A	knit 2 stitches together
	no stitch
M	make one stitch using strand between two stitches
lift 15 sts one by one over next st	one by one lift 15 stitches over the next stitch on the left hand needle and then knit the stitch (15 sts decreased)

Note! Chart is read from bottom to top, odd numbered rows from right to left and even numbered rows from left to right.

Instructions

Cast on 42 stitches, knit them and continue from row 1 of the chart, part 1. Knit rows 1 – 21 once, then continue from row 2 (part 1) and work 5 times rows 2 – 21, after that rows 2 – 20 once, omit now row 21 and work two last rows following part 2. Cast off stitches and cut the yarn. Form a big hole on the cast on edge of the scarf by sewing together the first and last stitches of the cast on row along the length of about half an inch (pictures 1 and 2). Finish yarn ends. Blocking or steaming isn't advisable as this scarf is supposed to look bubbly. While wearing pull the cast off edge through the hole of the cast on edge.

Written instructions

Abbreviations

k = knit

p = purl

yo = yarn over

yo2 = double yarn over

p2tog = purl 2 stitches together

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

M1 = make one stitch using strand between two stitches

lift 15 sts over next st = one by one lift 15 stitches over the next stitch on the left hand needle and then knit the stitch (15 sts decreased)

(x = knit symbols in brackets as many times as indicated

- = repeat enclosed instructions

Cast on 42 stitches, knit one row and continue as follows:

Row 1: yo, p2tog, k20, yo2, p2tog, k16, yo, p2tog

Row 2: yo, p2tog, k18, p1, k2, yo2, p2tog, k16, yo, p2tog

Row 3: yo, p2tog, k18, p1, k21, yo, p2tog

Row 4: yo, p2tog, k40, yo, p2tog

Row 5: yo, p2tog, k21, (yo2, p2tog,)x2, k15, yo, p2tog

Row 6: yo, p2tog, k17, (p1, k2,)x2, (yo2, p2tog,)x2 k15, yo, p2tog

Row 7: yo, p2tog, k17, p1, k2, p1, k23, yo, p2tog

Row 8: yo, p2tog, k44, yo, p2tog

Row 9: yo, p2tog, k23, (yo2, p2tog,)x3, k15, yo, p2tog

Row 10: yo, p2tog, k17, (p1, k2,)x3, (yo2, p2tog,)x3, k15, yo, p2tog

Row 11: yo, p2tog, k17, (p1, k2,)x2, p1, k26, yo, p2tog

Row 12: yo, p2tog, k50, yo, p2tog

Row 13: yo, p2tog, k26, (yo2, p2tog,)x4, k16, yo, p2tog

Row 14: yo, p2tog, k18, (p1, k2,)x4, (yo2, p2tog,)x4 k16, yo, p2tog

Row 15: yo, p2tog, k18, (p1, k2,)x3, p1, k30, yo, p2tog

Row 16: yo, p2tog, k58, yo, p2tog

Row 17: yo, p2tog, k30, (yo2, p2tog,)x5, k18, yo, p2tog

Row 18: yo, p2tog, k20, (p1, k2,)x5, (yo2, p2tog,)x5, k18, yo, p2tog

Row 19: yo, p2tog, k20, (p1, k2,)x4, p1, k35, yo, p2tog

Row 20: yo, p2tog, k1, lift 15 sts one by one over next st, k51, yo, p2tog

Row 21: yo, p2tog, k1, lift 15 sts one by one over next st, k18, yo2, p2tog, k16, yo, p2tog

After row 21 continue from row 2 and work 5 times rows 2 – 21, then rows 2 – 20 once, omit row 21 and then work the following two rows once:

Row 1: yo, p2tog, k1, lift 15 sts one by one over next st, k33, (k2tog)x3

Row 2: p2tog, k15, m1, k2, m1, k14, (p2tog)x3

Cast off stitches. Cut the yarn. Form a big hole on the cast on edge of the scarf by sewing together the first and last stitches of the cast on row along the length of about half an inch (look pictures 1

and 2). Finish yarn ends. Don't block as this scarf is supposed to look bubbly. While wearing pull the cast off edge through the hole on the cast on edge.

Picture 2: Form a big hole by sewing together the first and last stitches of the cast on row along the length of about half an inch.

Part 1

Ohje suomeksi

Huivin mallineule on reunapitsi vanhasta pitsimallikirjasta vuodelta 1884. Tein kuvattomasta ja kaaviottomasta ohjeesta mallitilkkuja ja kaaviota, kun sain idean, että leventämällä pitsimallia peilikuvalaan siitä saisi käytännöllisen kaulahuivin. Huivissa ei ole nurjaa eikä oikeaa puolta, sillä se on molemmilta puoliltaan samannäköinen. Myös huivin alku- ja loppupää muotoutuvat itsekseen ilman monia lisäyksiä ja kavennuksia.

Mitat: pituus 72 cm, leveys 23 cm, venyttämättä mitattuna

Lanka: noin 220 metriä tiheyteen sopivaa pöyheää mohair-, villa- tai sekoitelankaa (aran weight)

Langan neuletiheys: noin 15 - 16 s ja 21 krs = 10 cm sileää neuletta, neuletiheys ei ole ratkaiseva

Puikot: 5 - 6 mm tai valittuun lankaan sopivat

Kuvan vihreä huivi on tehty Rondo Lilie -langasta (80 % akryylia, 20 % mohairia) 5 mm:n puikoilla.

lisää silmukka poimimalla silmukoiden välinen lanka puikolle ja neulomalla se kiertään oikein

lift 15 sts one by one over next st

siirrä vasemmalla puikolla olevat seuraavan silmukan jälkeiset 15 silmukkaa silmukan yli ja neulo sen jälkeen silmukka oikein eli 16 silmukasta jää jäljelle yksi silmukka

Huom! Kaaviossa on jokainen kerros merkitty ja parittomat kerrokset neulotaan oikealta vasemmalle ja parilliset vasemmalta oikealle.

Luo 42 silmukkaa, neulo kerros oikein ja jatka sitten kaavion (Part 1) 1. kerroksesta. Toista kaavion 1. - 21 krs kerran, sitten 2. – 21. krs 5 kertaa (tai enemmän, jos haluat pitemmän huivin) ja lopuksi 2. - 20. krs kerran. Jätä sitten 21. kerros väliin ja neulo kaksi viimeistä kerrosta (Part 2). Päättää silmukat. Ompele huivin aloituspään oikea ja vasen reuna yhteen 1 - 2 sentin matkalta (katso picture 1 ja 2 englanninkielisestä osasta). Näin muodostuu huivin pähän aukko, josta huivin toinen pää vedetään läpi kaulaan laitettaessa. Päättää langanpää. Huivia ei suositella pingotettavaksi, sillä pinnan kuuluu olla kuplamaisen epätasainen.
