Supplies:

G hook Approximately 2 ounces acrylic worsted weight yarn polyfill stuffing

Gauge: 14 rows and 17 sc = 4 inches Gauge is not extremely important to this project; however, if your gauge is off, your letter may not be in the exact proportions as the photographed letters.



Notes:

Project is made in two pieces, from the bottom up.

Foundation single crochet stitch instructions: Insert hook in bottom of stitch just completed, yo pull through bottom of stitch, yo, pull through 2.

Instructions: Make two.

Ch 17.

Row 1: Sc in second ch from hook and each across. Ch 1, turn. (16 sc)

Row 2-5: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. (16 sc)

Row 6: Sc in first 5 sc. Ch 1, turn. (5 sc) Leave remaining stitches unworked in this row.

Row 7-11: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. (5 sc)

Row 12: Sc in each sc across. Ch 12, turn. (5 sc, 12 ch)

Row 13: Sc in second ch from hook and each ch and sc across. Ch 1, turn. (16 sc)

Row 14-17: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. (16 sc)

Row 18: Sc in first 5 sc. Ch 1, turn. (5 sc) Leave remaining stitched unworked in this

row.

Row 19-25: Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn. (5 sc)

Row 26: Sc in each sc across. 11 fsc. Ch 1, turn. (16 sts)

Row 27-30: Sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn. (16 sc)

Finish off, leaving long strand for sewing together two sides.

Assembly: Whip stitch together two sides of letter a little at a time, adding polyfill stuffing as you go. Be careful not to sew too much at once or you will have a hard time stuffing the letter.
