


## Heart of Muhu



### Introduction

This pattern is inspired by color motif from cotton stockings found on Muhu island, Estonia which were knitted between years 1910 and 1912. Stockings are in Museum of Muhu (JSM529:E639), original motif is published in book “Meite Muhu Mustrid” by Mai Meriste, Anu Pink and Anu Kabur, p. 52-53.



### Description and tips

Chart 1 includes only odd number rows. All even row stitches are knitted purlwise.

### Legend

- [square] k, knit
- [circle with dot] yo, yarn over
- [diagonal line] k2tog, knit 2 stitches together knitwise
- [backslash] ssk, slip 2 stitches as if to knit, then knit those 2 stitches together
- [hook] slip 1 knit 2, slip one stitch knitwise, knit 2 stitches together, pass slipped stitch over two stitches knit together
- [circle with dot inside square] bobble/nupp: knit 7 stitches out of one (knit, yarnover, knit, yarnover, knit etc), purl stitches together on the wrong side
