## Cable Stitch Coffee Sleeve

## **Materials:**

Sportweight yarn in color(s) of choice. (Try making the ribbed edges in a different color than the cable section for a different look!)

Crochet hook size f (3.75mm)

Special stitches: Front post dc (fpdc): Insert hook from front to back around post of dc on row below, complete as regular dc.

## **Bottom Ribbed Edge:**

Row 1: Ch 4, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in next 2 ch. Ch 1, turn.

Row 2: (Work in back loops only throughout) Sc in each sc across. Ch 1, turn.
Rows 3-48: Repeat row 2.

Join ends of band together with sl st. Turn band so seam in on wrong side.

## **Cable Section:**

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in end of each row around band. Join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Ch 1, turn. (48 sc)

Note: Ensure you have 48 sc on this rnd so that cable pattern will have correct spacing. Pattern requires a multiple of 8 stitches. Also, If you wish to create a larger sleeve, you can work a larger ribbed band (a multiple of 8 rows in length.)

Rnd 2: (Sc in next 3 sc, dc in next 2 sc, sc in next sc, dc in next 2 sc) around, join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Ch 1, turn. (6 cable sections)

Rnd 3: Sc in each st around. Join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Ch 1, turn.

Rnd 4: \*Sc in next 3 sc, (fpdc around dc 2 rows below) twice, sc in next sc, (fpdc around dc 2 rows below) twice\* repeat

between \*\* around, join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Ch 1, turn.

Rnd 5: Repeat rnd 3.

Rnd 6: (Twist rnd)

Ch 1, \*sc in next 3 sc, skip next 3 st, fpdc around each of next 2 dc, sc in last sc just skipped (to the right and closest to hook), fpdc around both dc just skipped (starting with the rightmost as per usual) – cable twist made.\* Repeat between \*\* around hat. Join with sl st to 1st sc.

Rnd 7: Repeat rnd 3.

(Tip: If you can't see all the stitches because of the twist, just keep in mind to work 5 sc across each cable section and 3 sc in between. Exact stitch placement isn't vital here.)

Rnd 8: Repeat rnd 4.

Note: This rnd is a little trickier if you haven't done a cable stitch before because you can't really see the 1<sup>st</sup> 2 dc that make up of the twist. Bear in mind that the exact stitch placement doesn't matter very much on these first 2 fpdc. Simply make the stitches at the right side of the twist as per photo. ©

Rnd 9: Repeat rnd 3.

Rnd 10: Repeat rnd 4.

Rnd 11: Repeat rnd 3.

Rnd 12: (2<sup>nd</sup> Twist rnd)

Repeat rnd 6.

Rnds 13-17: Repeat rnds 3 & 4, ending with rnd 3.

**Upper Ribbed Edge:** 

Row 1: Ch 4, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in next 2 ch, (sl st through both loops of next unworked sc on rnd 17 of cable section) twice, turn.



Row 2: Working in back loops only, sc in next 3 sc, ch 1, turn. Row 3: Working in back loops only, sc in next 3 sc, (sl st through both loops of next unworked sc on rnd 17 of cable section) twice, turn. Repeat rows 2 & 3 until all sc of rnd 17 are worked. Sl st ends of upper ribbed edge together with seam on wrong
