

## Call Me Cordelia Doll

### Materials:

Small amount sportweight or baby yarn

in light pink, cream, red

Crochet hook size d (3.25mm)

Optional 4.5mm eyes available from

[www.6060.etsy.com](http://www.6060.etsy.com)



### Head & Neck:

Rnd 1: Ch 2, 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook (6 sc)

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)

Rnd 3: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (18 sc)

Rnd 4: (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (24 sc)

Rnds 5-8: Work even on 24 sc.

*Inc and dec over rnds 9-11 to form cheeks:*

Rnd 9: Sc in next 8 sc, (2 sc in next sc) 3 times, sc in next 2 sc, (2 sc in next sc) 3 times, sc in last 8 sc. (30 sc)

Rnd 10: Work even on 30 sc.

Rnd 11: Sc in next 8 sc, (sc next 2 sc tog) 3 times, sc in next 2 sc, (sc in next sc, skip next sc) 3 times, sc in last 8 sc. (24 sc)

Rnd 12: (Skip next sc, sc in next 3 sc) around. (18 sc)

*Stuff head and cheeks.*

*If using 4.5mm eyes, attach before stuffing head. Otherwise, you can embroider eyes later.*

Rnd 13: (Skip next sc, sc in next 2 sc) around. (12 sc)

Rnds 14-15: Work even on 12 sc.

Rnd 16: (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (16 sc)

Fasten off.

### Body:

Rnd 17: With white, join with sc in any st on rnd 16, sc in each sc around.

Rnd 18: Work evn on 16 sc.

Rnd 19: (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (20 sc)

Rnd 20: (Sc in next 4 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (24 sc)

Rnd 21: Work even on 24 sc.

Rnd 22: (Sc in next 3 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (30 sc).

Rnds 23-28: Work even on 30 sc. On last rnd, sl st in next sc to join.

Fasten off.

*Stuff body.*

Flatten rnd 28 so cheeks of face are at front of doll. With white, sl st tog over 15 sc on rnd 28 to close body. Fasten off.

### Neck Ruffle:

With white, work (sl st, ch 3) around each sc on rnd 17. Join with sl st in same space as beg sl st. Fasten off.

### Arm (Make 2):

Rnd 1: With pink, ch 4, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in next sc, 3 sc in next sc, working along opposite side of foundation chain, sc in next ch, 2 sc in last ch. (8 sc).

Rnds 2-4: Sc even on 8 sc. At the end of rnd 4, join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Rnd 5: For thumb, ch 1, 3 sc in next sc, remove hook from loop, insert hook into 1<sup>st</sup> sc just made and pull lp through sc, sc in next 7 sc.

Rnds 6-11: Work even on 7 sc, skipping thumb. Do not stuff arm. Flatten rnd 11 of arm so that thumb is pointing up and sl st in place at shoulder so seam is toward back of body.

Fasten off.

Repeat for other arm and sew in place at opposite shoulder.



### Leg (Make 2):

Rnd 1: Ch 2, 5 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around. (10 sc)

Rnds 3-16: Work even on 10 sc. Join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc. Stuff legs lightly, if desired. Flatten end of rnd 16 and sew in place at bottom of body (see photo for placement).

### Hair:

Row 1: With red, ch 5, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook and in each ch across. Ch 1, turn. (4 sc)

Row 2: 2 sc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in last st. Ch 4, turn. (6 sc)

Row 3: 4 tr in same sp, 2 tr in each sc across to last sc, 5 tr in last sc.



For bangs (fringe), (ch 4, sl st in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, ch 4, sl st in same space). Ch 1, turn.

Row 4: Sc in each st across. Ch 1, turn. (18 sc)

Row 5: Sc in each sc across, for bangs, (ch 4, sl st in same sp) twice. Ch 1, turn.

Row 6-9: Repeat rows 4 & 5, twice. At end of row 9, ch 3.

Row 10: tr next 4 sc tog, (tr next 2 sc tog) 4 times, tr next 5 sc tog. Ch 1, turn.

Row 11: Sc in each sc across. (6 sc)

Row 12: Sc in 1<sup>st</sup> sc, skip next sc, sc in next 2 sc, skip next sc, sc in last sc. (4 sc)

Fasten off.

### Finishing:

Sew hair on top of head with bangs toward the front. See photos for placement.

**For braids**, cut 6 strands of yarn, each measuring approx. 7" or 10 cm (or longer, if desired). Fold each strand in half and join to side of hair (see photo). You will now have 12 pieces of yarn for each braid. Divide into 3 groups of 4 strands and braid to desired length. Fasten end with ribbon or length of yarn and tie into a bow. Trim ends of braid to desired length.

### Materials:

Small amount sportweight or baby yarn  
in pale yellow, white and lavender, or  
colors of choice.

Crochet hook size d (3.25mm)



### Dress:

Row 1: Beginning at top of waist  
with lavender, ch 26, sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch  
from hook and in each ch across. Ch  
1, turn. (25 sc)

Rows 2-4: Work even on 25 sc. Ch 1,  
turn. At end of row 4, sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> sc  
to form band. Omit (ch 1, turn).

### Skirt (begin working in rnds)

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in same space, ch 1,  
(sc, ch 1) in each sc around. Join  
with sl st to top of 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Rnd 2: Sl st in 1<sup>st</sup> ch-1 sp, ch 2, dc in  
same sp, (2 dc in next ch-1 sp)  
around. Join with sl st to top of beg  
ch-2.

Rnds 3-6: Ch 2, dc in each dc  
around. Join with sl st to top of beg  
ch-2.

Fasten off at end of rnd 6.

### Lace Edging:

With white, join with sc in any dc on  
hem of skirt, ch 3, sc in same sp,  
(sc, ch 3, sc) in each dc around. Join  
with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Fasten off.

### Bodice:

Row 1: Working in remaining loops  
of foundation ch at top of waist, skip  
1<sup>st</sup> 10 ch, join with sl st in next sc, ch  
1, sc in same sp and in next 4 sc.  
Leave remaining 10 ch unworked, ch  
1, turn.

Rows 2-4: Work even on 5 sc. Ch 1,  
turn. Omit ch-1 at end of row 4.

For armhole opening, ch 10, sl st in  
1<sup>st</sup> skipped ch lp at back of waist,  
turn and sl st back along 10 ch to  
front of bodice, sl st in each sc  
across bodice, ch 10, sl st in last  
skipped ch lp at back of waist  
(opposite side), turn and sl st back  
along 10 ch to front of bodice. Join  
with sl st to bodice and fasten off.



### Sleeves:



Rnd 1: With white, join with sc in any skipped ch lp at armhole opening, sc in each ch lp and in end of each row at side of bodice. Do not join. (24 sc)

Rnds 2-5: Work even on 24 sc.

Rnd 6: (Skip next sc, sc in next sc) around. (12 sc)

Rnd 7: Work even on 12 sc. Join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Rnd 8: For edging, (ch 3, sl st in next sc) around, ch 3, sl st to beg of rnd to join.

Fasten off.

Finishing: To tighten top of puffed sleeve, with wrong side of sleeve facing, join white with sl st around any sc on rnd 1 of sleeve, (skip next st, sl st around next st) around.

Fasten off.

Repeat on opposite sleeve.

Rnd 6: (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (24 sc)

Rnds 7-8: Work even on 24 sc. At end of rnd 8, join with sl st to 1<sup>st</sup> sc.

Rnd 9: For edging, (ch 3, sl st in next sc) around, ch 3, sl st to beg of rnd to join.

Fasten off.



Indent top of hat with finger (see photos).

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Hat: (Worked in back loops only throughout.)

Rnd 1:, With pale yellow, ch 2, 6 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook.

Rnd 2: 2 sc in each sc around. (12 sc)

Rnd 3: Work even on 12 sc.

Rnd 4: (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around. (18 sc)

Rnd 5: Work even on 18 sc.
