

Thermal Lace Cowl

A simple stitch pattern makes for a fast and easy lace. Great for single skeins or left-over sock yarns, the pattern adapts easily from fingering weight to worsted.

Fingering

Deborah Norville Serenity

37 g

170 yds

Size 5 circular needles 16-24 inch

Worsted

Wisdom Yarns Poems Silk

50 gr

109 yds

Size 9 circular needles 16-24 inch



Cast on 100 (70) stitches using a long tail cast on, or your favorite stretchy cast on. Join in the round (making sure not to twist), marking beginning of round, and knit 3 rounds plain.

Begin pattern stitch

R1

YO, K2, PYO2 (pass yarnover over the 2 knit stitches)

Repeat

R2

Knit



Repeat these 2 rows for the pattern stitch until close to desired length, or until there is enough yarn left for 3 rows knit and bindoff row.

Knit 3 rows.

Bind off, using a stretchy bindoff (Elizabeth Zimmerman's Sewn Bind off works very well.)

Block if needed, and enjoy!
