## Simple Crochet Cover

This is the simplest of crochet hot water bottle covers which you can embellish to suit.

The hot water bottle cover measures approximately 36 cm ( 14 inches) by 23 cm ( 9 inches) including the neck.

The bottom edge is left open and I have secured it with a crochet cord but buttons or ties would work equally well.

Different yarns and decorations will produce very different results.


Yarn: 100g Cheap variegated yarn
Notions: Scraps of contrasting yarn or 2-3
buttons.
Hook: 6.5 mm
Skill: Intermediate
Gauge: 4 inches = 10 sts and 8 rows of hdc

## Hot Water Bottle Cover:

The hot water bottle is worked in rounds starting at the neck.

The first 9 rounds are shown in the diagram at the bottom of the document.

Base Ch ch 8
Round 1 ch 3, count as first st, hdc into $4^{\text {rd }}$ ch from hook twice, hdc into next 6 ch, 5 hdc into last ch, working down the other side of the chains, hdc in next $6 \mathrm{ch}, 2$ hdc into next ch, sl st into top of $1^{\text {st }}$ st -22 stitches.

Round 2 ch 3 , count as first st, hdc into each st round, sl st into top of $1^{\text {st }}$ st -22 stitches.
Round 3 ch 3, count as first st, hdc into next 10 sts, 2 hdc into next st, hdc into next 10 sts, hdc into top of the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of previous round, sl st into top of $1^{\text {st }}$ st of this round -24 stitches.

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Round 4 and 5 ch 3 , count as $1^{\text {st }}$ st, hoc into each st round, st st into top of $1^{\text {st }}$ st -24 stitches.
Round 6 ch 3, count as $1^{\text {st }}$ st, *2 hdd into next st, hdc into next st ${ }^{*}$, repeat from * - * round, st st into top of $1^{\text {st }}$ st -36 stitches.

Round 7 and 8 ch 3 , count as $1^{\text {st }}$ st, hoc into each st round, st st into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{st}-36$ stitches.
Round 9 ch 3, count as $1^{\text {st }}$ st, *hd into next 2 sss, 2 hdc into next st*, repeat from * - * round, hdd into top of the $1^{\text {st }}$ st of previous round, asl st into top of $1^{\text {st }}$ st -48 stitches.

Rows 10-25 Repeat round 9 .
Fasten off and weave in ends.
Here I have secured the open bottom edge of the cover by threading a 75 cm ( 30 inch ) chain through the last row of stitches.
I have also placed a similar chain about a third from the top of the cover and added a crochet flower.
