## The Octagon

A simple and very quick beret style hat.
I made this using DK yarn but you could easily make it in a thicker yarn without changing the hook size which would make a warmer more wintry hat..

The hat measures around 22 inches circumference with a plenty of stretch.


Yarn: Marble by James C Brett - $1 / 2$ ball or other DK or worsted weight yarn. The thicker yarn will produce a stiffer and warmer hat.

Hook: 6mm
Skill: Easy
Gauge: 4 inches $=15$ sts and 7 rows of dc
Abbreviations:

| ch | Chain |

dc2tog Double Crochet 2 Stitches Together

## Hat:


ch 6 and join with a slip stitch to make a circle.
Round 1 ch 5, (count as dc, ch 2), (dc into centre of circle, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 2 ch 3, 2 dc into same st, ch 2, ( 3 dc into next dc, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 3 ch 3, dc into same st, dc into next, 2 dc into next, ch 2, (2 dc into next dc, dc into next, 2 dc into next, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 4 ch 3 , dc into same st, dc into next 3, 2 dc into next, ch 2, (2 dc into next dc, dc into next 3,2 dc into next, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 5 ch 3, dc into same st, dc into next 5, 2 dc into next, ch 2, (2 dc into next dc, dc into next 5,2 dc into next, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 6 ch 3 , dc into same st, dc into next 7, 2 dc into next, ch 2 , ( 2 dc into next dc, dc into next 7,2 dc into next, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 7 ch 3, dc into same st, dc into next 9, 2 dc into next, ch 2, (2 dc into next dc, dc into next 9,2 dc into next, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 8 ch 3, dc into next 5, 2 dc into next, dc into next 6, dc into 2-ch space, (dc into next 6 dc, 2 dc into next, dc into next 6, dc into 2-ch space) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 9 ch 3, dc into next 5, dc2tog, dc into next 7, (dc into next 6 dc, dc2tog, dc into next 7) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 10 ch 2, dc into next st (count as dc2tog), dc into next 9, dc2tog, ch 2, (dc2tog, dc into next 9 , dc2tog, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 11 ch 2, dc into next st (count as dc2tog), dc into next 7, dc2tog, ch 2, (dc2tog, dc into next 7, dc2tog, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 12ch 2, dc into next st (count as dc2tog), dc into next 5, dc2tog, ch 2, (dc2tog, dc into next 5, dc2tog, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 13ch 2, dc into next st (count as dc2tog), dc into next 3, dc2tog, ch 2, (dc2tog, dc into next 3, dc2tog, ch 2) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round $\mathbf{1 4}$ ch 3, dc into next 4 , dc into each ch of 2 -ch space, (dc into next 5, dc into each ch of 2 -ch space) 7 times, slip stitch into top of $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{dc}$.

Round 15 sc into each st round, slip stitch into $1^{\text {st }}$, fasten off and sew away the ends.
