This simple scarf uses that special button that was too pretty to leave behind or one that matches your variegated yarn to a tee. Wear Bright Spot under a coat or as an all day

> accessory in place of a necklace to keep you warm. *My mom was wearing a similar mini-scarf that she had* purchased (!) and the combination of the texture and button just made the outfit. I thought this would be just the right quick knit so many of us look for at the holidays! The beauty is that it can be made with any stash yarn on *hand!* Even great for that special 4 ounce handspun skein!

Materials

***Bulky:** Berroco Borealis (60% acrylic/40% wool; 108 yds/100g); color: #5059 Olafsvik; 1 skein) or

*Handspun: 100 g single or 2-ply approximately 110 yards

*Size 8/5 mm or size needed to obtain gauge *one button 1¾- 2¼ inches *tapestry needle

Gauge 3.5 stitches and 5 rows/inch

Finished Size

5 inches wide x 30 inches long approximately

BRIGHT SPOT

Instructions

Cast on 19 stitches.

Begin Double Moss pattern, continuing until piece measures 3 inches from cast on edge.

Buttonhole:

Row 1: Continue 8 stitches in pattern, cast off 3 stitches, complete row in pattern (16 stitches)

Row 2: Work 8 stitches in pattern, cast 3 stitches on by backward loop method, complete row in pattern (19 stitches)

Work in pattern until piece measures 30 inches.

Bind off. Weave in ends.


Sew favorite, splashy button in place, centered 3 inches from end opposite buttonhole.

Wear happily and add a little Bright Spot to your day.



Double Moss Pattern

(multiple of 2 + 1)



Instructions:

Row 1 (RS): (k1, p1) 9 times, k1. Row 2 (WS): k1, (p1, k1) 9 times. Row 3 (RS): (p1, k1) 9 times, p1. Row 4 (WS): p1, (k1, p1) 9 times.
