

Harlequin Hoodie



FINISHED SIZES

- Size **Toddler**:
 - 12" hood height (after adding cowl)
 - 8" hood depth
 - 4" cowl width, 45" circumference
- Size **Child**:
 - 14 ½" hood height (after adding cowl)
 - 9" hood depth
 - 5" cowl width, 53" circumference
- Size **Adult**:
 - 17" hood height (after adding cowl)
 - 10" hood depth
 - 6" cowl width, 61" circumference

MATERIALS

- Medium (4) weight yarn
 - Colorful hoodie pictured above and on page 5 (1 skein of each color will make any size):
 - Lion Brand Vanna's Choice in Lime, Sapphire, and Raspberry
 - Lion Brand Vanna's Choice Baby in Duckie
 - Red Heart Soft in Lilac, Tangerine, and Turquoise
 - Red Heart Soft Baby Steps in Aqua & Strawberry
 - Loops & Threads Impeccable in Lush & Cherry
 - Grey hoodie pictured on page 5:
 - Main Color: Lion Brand Vanna's Choice (85g / 145yds per skein) in Silver Heather
 - 2 skeins will make the Toddler size, 3 skeins are needed to make the Child and Adult sizes
 - Accent Colors: Lion Brand Vanna's Choice (100g / 170yds per skein) in Aquamarine and Peacock – 1 skein of each color, minimal yardage used
 - Approximate weight & total yardage needed for each size:
 - Toddler – 153g / 260yds
 - Child – 210g / 357yds
 - Adult – 275g / 468yds
- Size I-9 (5.5mm) crochet hook

GAUGE

With an I-hook and medium (4) weight yarn, chain a multiple of 3 plus 1, then follow Rows 1 – 4 of the HOOD pattern. Repeat Rows 3 & 4 to make a gauge swatch.

- 12 sts = 4 inches, 8 rows = 4 inches

ABBREVIATIONS USED

st(s) = stitch(es)

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

ch = chain

sp = space

yo = yarn over

dc3tog = double crochet 3 stitches together

sc3tog = single crochet 3 stitches together

PATTERN NOTES

Color changes have been omitted from the pattern for ease of reading. To make a colorful hoodie as shown on page 1, change colors after every 2 rows while working the granny stripe pattern on the HOOD & COWL. Then work the last two rounds of the EDGING in different colors.

Changing colors at the end of a row: When working the last stitch of the row, leave the last 2 loops on the hook. Instead of finishing the stitch with the current color, yarn over with the new color and complete the stitch. Then continue with the pattern.

double crochet 3 stitches together (dc3tog) = (yo, insert hook into designated st, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops)(repeat 2 more times), yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook

single crochet 3 stitches together (sc3tog) = insert hook into 1st st, pull up a loop, (insert hook into next st, pull up a loop)(repeat 1 more time), yo and pull through all 4 loops on hook

INSTRUCTIONS

HOOD

Size **Toddler**: ch 61

Size **Child**: ch 70

Size **Adult**: ch 79

- Row 1 (wrong side): dc in 4th ch from hook and in each ch across, turn
 - Size **Toddler**: 58 dc
 - Size **Child**: 67 dc
 - Size **Adult**: 76 dc
- Row 2 (right side): ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in 1st dc, (skip next 3 dc, 3 dc between 3rd & 4th dc)(repeat across), end row with 2 dc between last dc and beginning ch-3, turn
 - Size **Toddler**: 18 3-dc shells & 2 2-dc shells
 - Size **Child**: 21 3-dc shells & 2 2-dc shells
 - Size **Adult**: 24 3-dc shells & 2 2-dc shells
- Row 3: ch 3, 3 dc between the 2-dc shell and 3-dc shell, (3 dc between next 3-dc shells)(repeat across), end row with 3 dc between last 3-dc shell and 2-dc shell, 1 dc to top of ch-3, turn
 - Size **Toddler**: ch-3, 19 3-dc shells, 1 dc
 - Size **Child**: ch-3, 22 3-dc shells, 1 dc
 - Size **Adult**: ch-3, 25 3-dc shells, 1 dc
- Row 4: ch 3, dc in 1st dc, (3 dc between next 3-dc shells)(repeat across), end row with 2 dc between last 3-dc shell and ch-3, turn
 - Size **Toddler**: 18 3-dc shells & 2 2-dc shells
 - Size **Child**: 21 3-dc shells & 2 2-dc shells
 - Size **Adult**: 24 3-dc shells & 2 2-dc shells
- Repeat Rows 3 & 4 for pattern:
 - Size **Toddler**: repeat for a TOTAL count of 14 rows on HOOD, do not fasten off last color
 - Size **Child**: repeat for a TOTAL count of 16 rows on HOOD, do not fasten off last color
 - Size **Adult**: repeat for a TOTAL count of 18 rows on HOOD, do not fasten off last color

Fold fabric in half, lengthwise, with right sides together. Line up stitches from last row. With current yarn, sl st the last row together. This forms the back seam of HOOD. Fasten off, weave in ends, and turn HOOD right side out.

COWL

With hood opening facing you, join yarn to bottom right corner (same space as 1st ch from start of HOOD) [Figure 1].

Size **Toddler**: ch 89

Size **Child**: ch 107

Size **Adult**: ch 125

Being careful not to twist the chain, join to the opposite corner of hood [Figure 2]. Position hood upside down, with the long chain to your left.

- Round 1: ch 3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in 1st ch from corner and in each ch across, continuing around base of HOOD, work one 3 dc-shell for every 2 rows on HOOD [Figures 3 & 4] then sl st join to top of beginning ch-3
 - Size **Toddler**: 90 dc on cowl, 14 ³ dc-shells around base of hood
 - Size **Child**: 108 dc on cowl, 16 ³ dc-shells around base of hood
 - Size **Adult**: 126 dc on cowl, 18 ³ dc-shells around base of hood
- Round 2 [Figures 5 & 6]: sl st in each of next 2 dc, sl st in sp between current dc and next dc, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, (skip next 3 dc, 3 dc between 3rd & 4th dc)(repeat around COWL), working around base of HOOD, (3 dc between next 3-dc shells)(repeat around HOOD), sl st join to top of beginning ch-3
 - Size **Toddler**: 44 ³ dc-shells
 - Size **Child**: 52 ³ dc-shells
 - Size **Adult**: 60 ³ dc-shells
- Round 3: sl st in each of next 2 dc, sl st in sp between 3-dc shells, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, (3 dc between next 3-dc shells)(repeat around), sl st join to top of beginning ch-3
 - Size **Toddler**: repeat Round 3 for a TOTAL count of 4 rounds on COWL then fasten off
 - Size **Child**: repeat Round 3 for a TOTAL count of 6 rounds on COWL then fasten off
 - Size **Adult**: repeat Round 3 for a TOTAL count of 8 rounds on COWL then fasten off



EDGING

(all sizes)

The edging will add 2 rounds of the granny stripe pattern to the front of your hood and the top of your cowl, plus a round of sc, then a final round with picots.

Working along the top edge of COWL and front of HOOD, with right side facing you, insert hook between any 3-dc shells & pull up chosen color.

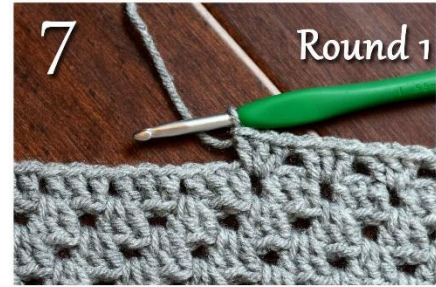
- Round 1 [Figures 7 & 8]: ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc between shells around HOOD & COWL, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3
 - work a dc3tog into each corner sp
- Round 2: sl st in each of next 2 dc, sl st into sp between shells, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, 3 dc between shells around HOOD & COWL, sl st join to top of beginning ch-3
 - dc3tog the following [Figure 9]:
 1. sp *before* the dc3tog st from previous round
 2. the dc3tog st from previous round
 3. sp *after* the dc3tog st from previous round
- Round 3: ch 1 (does not count as 1st sc), sc in same st and in each st around HOOD & COWL, sl st join to 1st sc
 - sc3tog the 3 corner most sts [Figure 10]
- Round 4 [Figures 11 & 12]: ch 1, sc in same sc and in next 2 sc, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, (1 sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook)(repeat around HOOD & COWL), sl st join to 1st sc, then fasten off
 - sc3tog the 3 corner most sts

Working on bottom edge of COWL, with right side facing you, insert hook into any dc & pull up chosen color.

- Round 1: ch 1 (does not count as 1st sc), sc in same dc and in each dc around, sl st join to 1st sc
- Round 2: ch 1, sc in same sc and in next 2 sc, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook, (1 sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 2, sl st in 2nd ch from hook)(repeat around), sl st join to 1st sc, then fasten off.

Weave in ends and attach pom poms or tassels to tip of hood, if desired.

Extras...

To help plan a colorful hoodie, with color changes every 2 rows:

- Size **Toddler**:
 - Hood will have a TOTAL of 8 granny stripes. Seven stripes are made while working the hood and another one is added when the edging is worked around the front.
 - Cowl will have a TOTAL of 3 granny stripes. Two stripes are made while working the cowl and another one is added when the edging along the top is worked.
- Size **Child**:
 - Hood will have a TOTAL of 9 granny stripes. Eight stripes are made while working the hood and another one is added when the edging is worked around the front.
 - Cowl will have a TOTAL of 4 granny stripes. Three stripes are made while working the cowl and another one is added when the edging along the top is worked.
- Size **Adult**:
 - Hood will have a TOTAL of 10 granny stripes. Nine stripes are made while working the hood and another one is added when the edging is worked around the front.
 - Cowl will have a TOTAL of 5 granny stripes. Four stripes are made while working the cowl and another one is added when the edging along the top is worked.



Hood looks lovely in a solid color too! Just choose a couple accent colors for the last two rounds of the edging and pom poms.
