

Watch Cap Lite



Hat:

Gauge: 6 stitches per inch, 7 rows per inch.

Two size 6 circular needles with DK weight yarn. Cast in 4 with figure 8 cast on.
2 per needle.

Row 1: P around
Row 2: M1, P1, repeat around (8 sts)
Row 3: P around
Row 4: M1, P1, repeat around (16 sts)
Row 5: P around
Row 6: P1, M1 P1, repeat around (24 sts)
Row 7: P around
Row 8: P1, M1, P2, repeat around (32 sts)
Row 9: P around
Row 10: P1, M1, P3, repeat around (40 sts)
Row 11: P around
Row 12: P1, M1, P4, repeat around (48 sts)
Row 13: P around
Row 14: P1, M1, P5, repeat around (56 sts)
Row 15: P around
Row 16: P1, M1, P6, repeat around (64sts)
Row 17: P around
Row 18: P1, M1, P7, repeat around (72 sts)
Row 19: P around
Row 20: P1, M1, P8, repeat around (80 sts)
Row 21: P around
Row 22: P1, M1, P9, repeat around (88 sts)
Row 23: P around

Row 24: P1, M1, P10, repeat around (96 sts)
Row 25: P around
Row 26: P1, M1, P11, repeat around (104 sts)
Row 27: P around
Row 28: P1, M1, P12, repeat around (112 sts)
Rows 29: P around

Keep Purling around until the hat is long enough to reach the middle of the ear of who the hat is intended for. Then do the decrease rounds

Decrease rounds:

Row 1: P1, P2Tog, P11, Repeat around. (104)
Row 2: P around
Row 3: P1, P2Tog, P10, Repeat around. (96)

Then do the ribbing.

Ribbing:

Do a P2 K2 ribbing for as long as you desire it to be. Bind off very loosely.

Note: If you need the hat to be child size then stop increasing at row 22. Purl the row after the increase row. Skip the decrease rounds and do the ribbing.
