Debbie Inspired Cowl



When looking for something to make one day I was shown a pattern for scarf in a Debbi Bliss magazine. I found this pattern to be a very easy to follow pattern and really liked using it. So from there I was able to make my own cowl version of the pattern knit in the round.

YARN and MATERIALS

Berroco Blackstone Tweed color # 2642 (pink) Berroco Mica color # 1143 (green) Size 11 24" Circular Knitting Needle Darning Needle Stitch Marker

GUAGE

- In 4 inches there will be 14 stitches following the pattern
 - 16 rows by 4 inches.

PATTERN

- 1. Cast On
 - a. Cast on 108 stitches with the Blackstone tweed
- 2. Place marker
 - a. To show where each row beings and ends.
- 3. Knit two rows
- 4. *(Knit 2 together) 3 times, (YO, Knit 1) 6 times, (Knit 2 together) 3 times* Repeat this until the end of the row
- 5. Purl one row
- 6. Repeat # 3 and 4
- 7. Purl one row with the Mica
- 8. Repeat sequence between #3-7 for about 4 times
- 9. Knit one row with Blackstone
- 10. Bind off and weave in ends
