

## Hot Red Ribbed Scarf



This lightweight and yet durable scarf will keep you both warm and stylish all winter long. Mau Works™ line of scarves are perfect as gifts for friends, loved ones or even to treat yourself. This particular scarf was designed using the basic rib stitch pattern.

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Sizing:** Teen - Adult

**Yarn and Needles:**

- Worsted Weight Hot Red Yarn
- Size 10.5 US (6.5mm) knitting needles.

**Gauge:** 5 stitches and 5 rows per squared inch over ribbed stitch.

**Abbreviations:**

K	knit
L	left
P	purl
R	right
st	stitch

**Stitches Used:**

**Knit St-**

- Hold the needle with the cast on stitches in your L hand and the empty one in your R hand.
- With yarn behind the needles, insert R needle into front of the stitch closest to the tip of the L needle from L to R.
- Wrap the yarn around the inserted R needle clockwise. With your R hand, bring the R needle (with the loop of yarn) toward you and through the stitch slipping the old stitch off the needle.
- Pull yarn to tighten the new stitch on right needle.

**Purl St-**

- Hold the needle with the cast on stitches in your L hand and the empty one in your R hand.
- With yarn behind the needles, insert R needle into front of the stitch closest to the tip of the L needle from R to L.
- Wrap the yarn around the inserted R needle clockwise. With your R hand, bring the R needle

- (with the loop of yarn) away from you and through the stitch slipping the old stitch off the needle
- Pull yarn to tighten the new stitch on right needle
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### **Pattern Instructions:**

Cast on 28 st.

**Row 1:** \*K1,P1 across. Repeat from \* across. Turn.

**Repeat Row 1 until desired length. Bind off.**
