Spidey Senses Scarf



MATERIALS

App 4 oz red worsted Weight Yarn App 1 oz blue worsted weight yarn Small amount black worsted Weight Yarn Size I – 5.5 mm Crochet Hook Yarn Needle

FINISHED SIZE Scarf pictured is

Please note: There are instructions at the end on how to make this scarf in any size!

GAUGE 7 sts and 8 rows of sc = 2"

DIRECTIONS

With red, ch16.

Row 1: Sc in 2^{nd} ch from hook and across.

Row 2 – 35: Ch 1, turn. Sc across.

Change to blue at the end of Row 25.

Row 36: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the nx 8 sts, change to red. Sc across.

Row 37: Ch 1, turn. Sc in the nx 7 sts, change to blue.

Row 38 – 105: Rep Rows 36 – 37.

FO blue after Row 105.

Row 106 – 140: Ch 1, turn. Sc across.

DO NOT FO

FIRST HAND

Row 1: Ch 1, turn. Dec, sc in nx 11 sts, dec.	(13 sc)
Row 2: Ch 1, turn. Dec, sc in nx 9 sts, dec.	(11 sc)
Row 3: Ch 1, turn. Sc across.	(11 sc)
Row 4: Ch 1, turn. 2 sc in nx st. Sc in nx 9 sts. 2 sc in nx st.	(13 sc)
Row 5: 2 sc in nx st. Sc in nx 11 sts. 2 sc in nx st.	(15 sc)
Row 6 – 9: Ch 1, turn. Sc across. Ch 10 at the end of Row 9.	(15 sc)

Row 10: Sc in 2 nd ch from hook and across.	(24 sc)
Row 11: Ch 1, turn. Sc across. 2 sc in last st.	(25 sc)
Row 12: Ch 1, turn. Dec, sc across.	(24 sc)
Row 13: Ch 1, turn. Sc in nx 15 sts. Leave rem sts unworked.	(15 sc)
Row 14 – 20: Ch 1, turn. Sc across.	(15 sc)
Row 21: Ch 1, turn. Sc in nx 3 sts. Leave rem sts unworked.	(3 sc)
Row 22 – 30: Ch 1, turn. Sc across.	(3 sc)
Row 31: Ch 1, turn. Sc 3 tog.	(1 sc)
FO.

Skip nx st from Row 20, join red with sc in nx st.

Rep Rows 21 - 30 3 more times for 4 fingers.

SECOND HAND

Make sure that the blue part of the scarf is on your left side. That way the hands will be the same way

Join red with sc in the first st of the foundation row.

Rep Row 1 - 31 of First Hand.

EDGING

Join red with sc in side of the first row after blue. Sc evenly around entire scarf, working 3 sc in each finger tip and changing to blue as needed Join to first st.

FO

FINISHING

If desired, stitch black "webs" over **ONLY RED** parts of the scarf. Tack the 2 middle fingers down to look like Spiderman shooting a web.

***NOTE: To make the scarf longer is easy. Just think of it right now as in 4 parts of 35 rows each. If you want it longer add the same number of rows to each section. So, if you add 5 extra rows to the first section, add 5 more to each section after as well. Watch your gauge and do your math to figure out the length of scarf you want.

MAMA24BOYZ'S TIPS AND TECHNIQUES

sc - single crochet: Insert hook in next st, draw up a lp, yo, draw through both lps on hook to complete stitch.

hdc - half double crochet: Yo, insert hook in nx st or sp, draw up a lp, (3 lps on hook), yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook to complete stitch.

beg - beginning

ch - chain

dc - double crochet: Yo, insert hook in nx st or sp, draw up a lp, (3 lps on hook), (yo, draw through 2 lps on hook) twice to complete stitch.

dec - Single Crochet Decrease: Insert hook in st indicated, draw up a lp, insert hook in nx st, draw up a lp (3 lps on hook), yo, draw through last 3 lps on hook to complete stitch.

lp(s) - loop(s)

rep - repeat

rnd - round

nx - next

RS - Right Side facing you

sk - skip

st(s) - stitch(es)

sl st - slip stitch

sp(s) - space(s)

tog - together

WS - Wrong Side facing you

hd dec - Half Double Crochet Decrease: Yo, insert hook in st indicated, draw up a lp, yo and insert hook in nx st, draw up a lp, yo, draw through last 5 lps on hook to complete stitch.

Dc dec - **Double Crochet Decrease**: Yo, insert hook in st indicated, draw up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook, yo, insert hook in nx st, draw up a lp, yo, draw through 2 lps on hook, (3 lps on hook), yo and draw through last 3 lps on hook to complete stitch.

FLO - Front Loop Only: Insert hook in front lp of nx st as indicated.


BLO - Back Loop: Insert hook in back loop of nx st as indicated.

Yo - yarn over

FR - Foundation Row

FO - Fasten Off

*To make a neater edge on your finished piece, work your beginning row in the back ridge of your foundation chain.



*To make weaving in ends easier, wherever you can, crochet over the tail while continuing working on your piece. Other ends should be left long then weaved 2" one way and 2" back the other way to secure the end.

*If you are making an ami, weave your end into the ami one way then out the other side and through again. Cut the tail close to the ami and play around with it to get it back inside.

*To change colours its easiest to work to the end of where you need colour 1, then begin working your final stitch, but use the new colour to finish the stitch. Cover the old colour with the new colour by working over it.

*When joining a new strand of yarn to a piece, join your yarn in the stitch BEFORE the joining. This way the joining won't be as noticeable.

*Join with a sc instead of (sl st, ch 1, sc) where applicable. This makes your join less noticeable.

*When dec at the beg of the next row, do not ch 1 when you turn. This will get rid of the "step" look to the piece and leaves a cleaner edge.
