Broken Rib Cowl



Materials:

Yarn: Approx 350 yards of worsted-weight yarn – this pattern would be especially nice using a hand painted yarn to show off the color variation.

Needles: Size 8 US circular needle (24"/60cm).

Note: the size needle noted may not give the correct gauge – always knit a swatch to make sure that you are close enough to match the desired gauge.

Gauge: 18 stitches/ 4in in pattern

Instructions:

Cast on 110 stitches. (I like the long tail method but any stable cast on will work well). Join the round.

Row 1: Knit

Row 2: K1, P1 across

Alternate row 1 and row 2 until the cowl is the length preferred. The cowl in the picture measures 15" long. Cast off and weave in the ends.
