

Betty Bobble Lace Hat design by: Midnight Knitter
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## Materials:

2 skeins Spud and Chloe Outer (available at kpixie.com)
needles: US 11 circular, ${ }^{16}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ long
and US 11 double pointed
Gauge: 3.5 sts per inch, stockinette on US 11
Size: womens average (meant to sit on top of head)

## Abbreviations:

st(s)=stitch(es)
k=knit
$\mathrm{p}=$ purl
p2tog=purl 2 sts together
k2tog=knit 2 sts together
sl1=slip 1 stitch knitwise
PM = place marker
RM=remove marker
skp=slip 1 st knitwise, k1, pass slipped stitch over yo= yarn over
m1 (make 1)=insert left needle from front to back under strand of yarn that runs between last stitch on left needle and first stitch on right needle; knit stitch thru back loop.
bobble: (worked over 2 sts, WORK LOOSLEY) k into front and back of next 2 sts, turn;
p2, p2tog, turn; sl1, k2tog

## Instructions:

With US 11 needles cast on 48 sts. Join to form circle, PM (at end of every round, slip marker unless otherwise instructed).

Round 1: *k3, p1; repeat from * around
Rounds 2, 3, 4, 5: repeat Round 1
Round 6: k1, m1, k1, m1, k3, m1, *k4, inc; repeat from * around to last 11 sts, $k 4, m 1, k 1, m 1, k 3, m 1, k 1, m 1, k 2$. 63 sts.

Round 7: k around.
Round 8: *k7, work bobble; repeat from * around. (push bobbles from the inside towards the outside of the hat)

Round 9: *k2tog, k1, yo, k1, yo, k1, skp, sl1, k1; repeat from * around.

Round 10: k1, *yo, k5, yo, k2tog, skp; repeat from * around to last 8 sts, yo, k5, yo, k2tog, sl 1, RM, then sl that st back to left needle, skp, PM. (this step is the same as the entire row but you have to remove the marker and then place it after working the last skp to setup for the next rounds)

Round 11: k2, *yo, k9; repeat from * to last 7 sts, yo, k7. 70 sts.

Round 12: *k8, skp; repeat from * around. 63 sts
Round 13: *k2, yo, k3, k2tog, k2; repeat from * around.
Round 14: k around
Round 15: *k2tog, yo, k2, bobble, k3; repeat from * around.

Round 16: $k$ around to last st, slip st to right needle, RM, slip back to left needle, PM (this round moves the marker to setup the next round)

Round 17: *k2tog, yo, k2, skp, k2tog, k1; repeat from * around. 49 sts

Round 18: *k4, yo, skp, k1; ; repeat from * around to last st, not working last k1, slip last st to right needle, RM, slip st back to left needle, PM.

Round 19: *k2 tog, k5; repeat from * around to last 7 sts, k2tog, k4, slip last st to right needle, RM, slip st back to left needle, PM. 42 sts

Round 20: *k1, yo, k4, k2tog; repeat from * around.
Round 21: k around
Round 22: *yo, k4, k2tog; repeat from * around.
Round 23: k around.
Round 24: *skp, k2, k2tog; repeat from * around. 28 sts.
Round 25: k around.
Round 26: *skp, k2; repeat from * around.
Round 27: *k1, k2tog; repeat from * around.
Cut yarn and pull thru remaining sts to close.
