

# A variation on the Norwegian Hardanger mitten

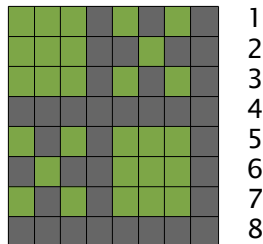
## NEEDLE SIZE

5 Double pointed needles or 2 circular needles size 3,5 mm / US 3

## THE PATTERNS

Ribbed pattern : [K2,p2]. Repeat to the end of the round.

The intarsia pattern :

## SYMBOLS

/ = A right slanted decrease. The traditional method used is : k2tog tbl .

\ = A left slanted decrease. The traditional method used is : k2tog.

## DECREASES

\ = Left slanted decrease . Traditional methode : K2tog tbl

/ = Right slanted decrease. Traditional methode : K2tog



Grey decrease

Green decrease

## THE MITTEN

Cast on 48 stitches

Knit 25 rounds of the ribbed pattern.

Start knitting intarsia pattern Right or Left.

If you want markers, place as shown in chart.

Knit thumb opening where shown in pattern : K9 (transfer to scrap yarn), cast on 9.

Continue knitting the intarsia pattern.

Decrease as described and charted.

Decrease until 8 stitches are left. Pull thread through.

## THE THUMB

Transfer the 9 stitches on the scarp yarn to 2 dpls or a circular needle.

Pick up 1 stitch on each side.

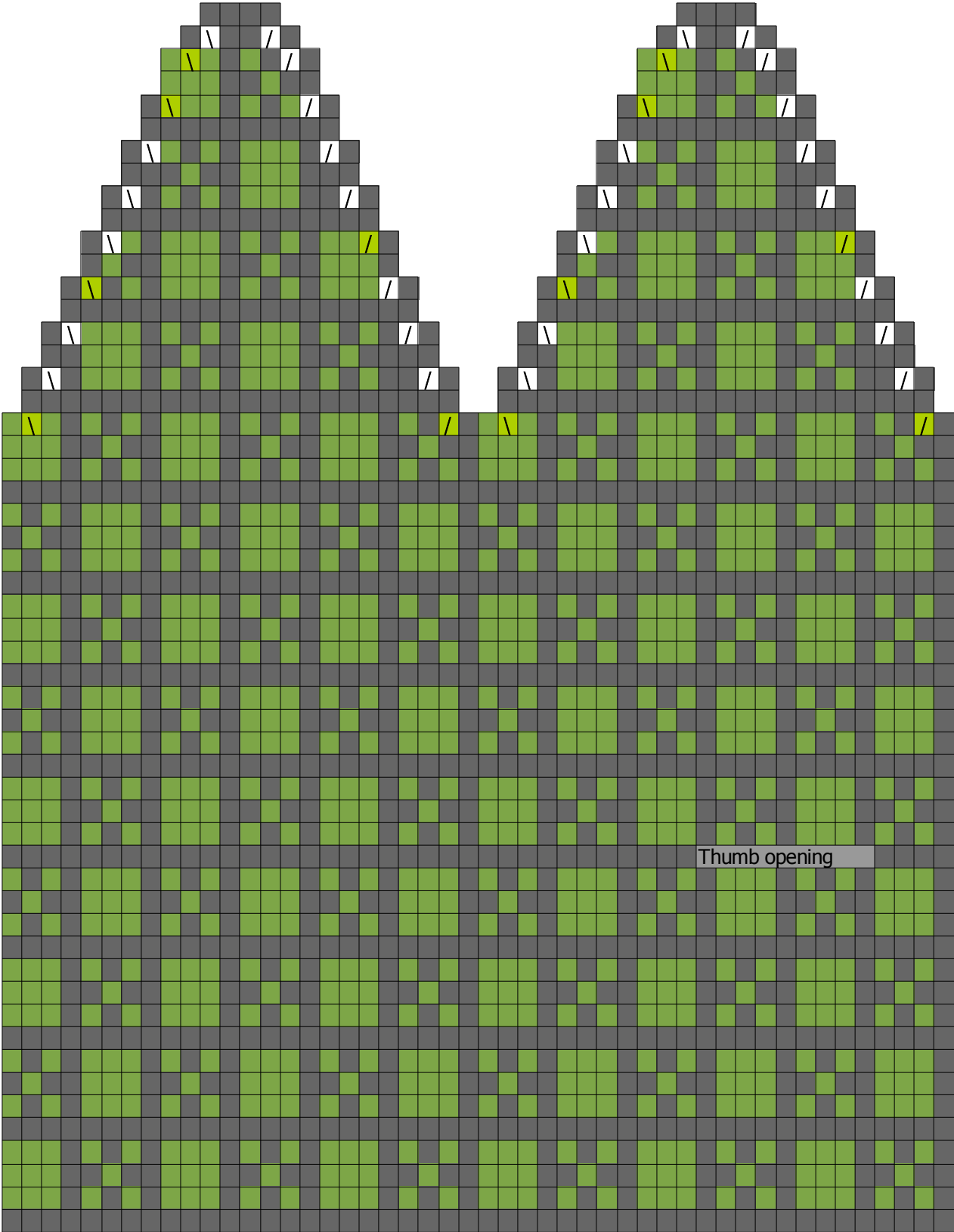
Pick up 9 stitches on the opposite side. Divide stitches on 2 dpls or a circular needle.

Pick up 1 stitch on each side.

Knit the intarsia pattern for the right or left thumb. Make sure the patterns match.

Decrease until 6 stitches are left. Pull thread through.

THE RIGHT HAND PATTERN

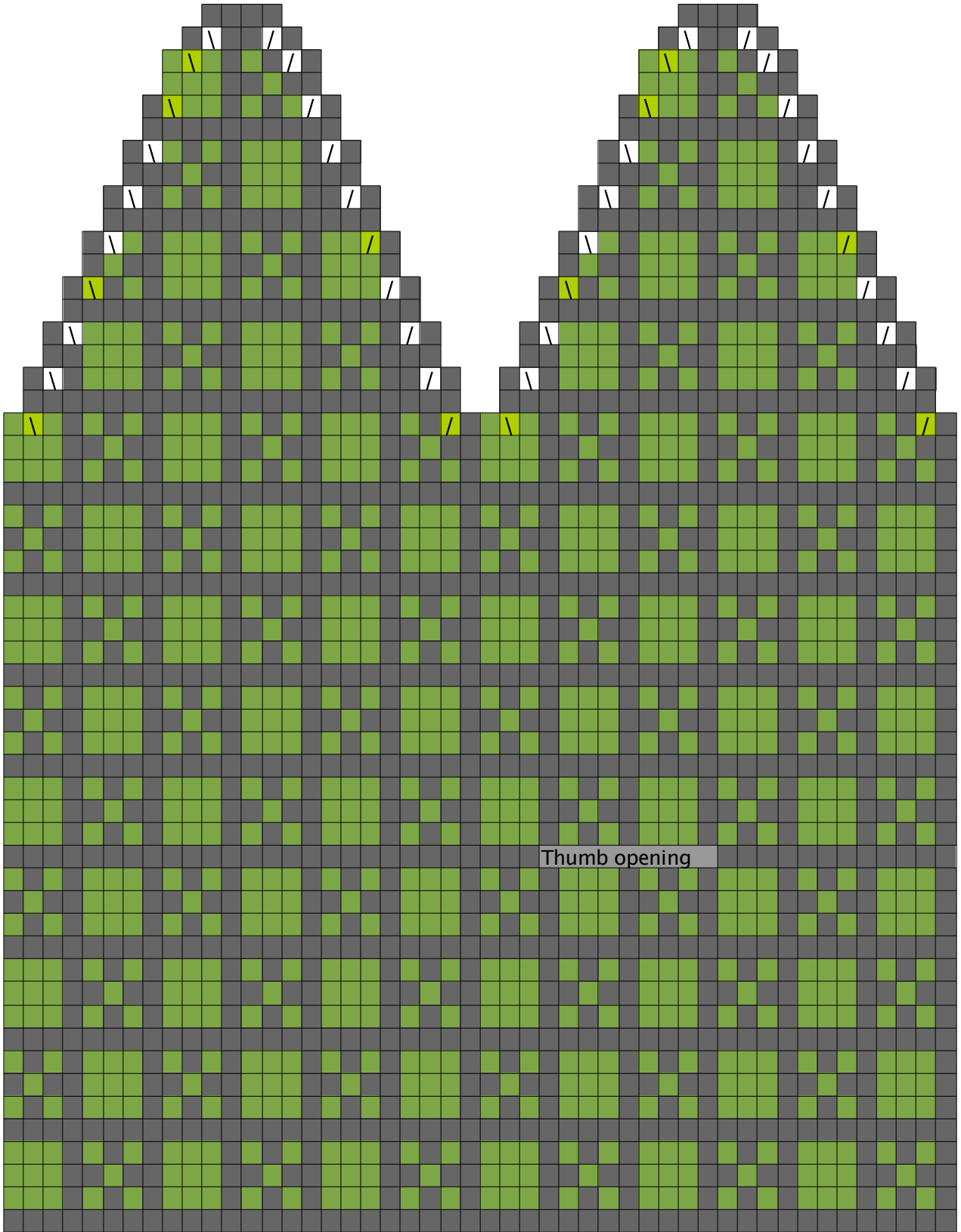
