

Materials

Rico Design Creative Bonbon; 1 ball, or alternative super-bulky yarn. 60m used for hat, extra for pom-pom.

Needles & Notions

6mm and 8mm DPNs, or needles for your preferred method of working small circumferences in the round.

Large tapestry needle for sewing up.

Abbreviations

k = knit

p = purl

k2tog = knit two together (knit two stitches together as if they were one).



Nightcloud

This is a simple hat with a slight slouch made in thick, super soft and warm yarn, topped off with a wonderfully fluffy pompom. Super quick and extremely simple to knit – perfect for beginners.

Sizes: S/M, (I) = head circumference: 48-50 cm/19-21'' (56-58-cm/22, 23'')

58cm/22-23")

Gauge: 11sts and 13 rounds to measure 10x10cm

(4x4in) in stockinette stitch.

Sizes:

s/m, (I) = head circumference: 48-50cm/19-21" (56-58cm/22-23")

Pattern instructions:

With 6mm needles, C/O 44 (48) sts using Alternating cast on or any other stretchy cast on of your preference and join to knit in the round, being careful not to twist.

Brim:

P1, place marker. This marks new beginning of round.

Round 1: (k1, p1) to end of round.

Repeat Round 1 until brim measures 5cm (2") from cast on edge.

Body of hat:

Change to 8mm needles

Round 1: Knit all stitches.

Repeat Round 1 until knitting measures 22cm (9") from cast on edge.

Decreases:

Round 1: (k2, k2tog) 11 (12) times.

Round 2: Knit all stitches.

Round 3: (k1, k2tog) 11 (12) times.

Round 4: (k2tog) 11 (12) times.

Finishing:

Break yarn, leaving a 20cm (8") tail, threading through all remaining stitches and drawing tight.

Weave in all ends and use remaining yarn to make a large pompom to adorn hat if desired.
