



Lineas Cowl

**Size:**

56" Around x 8" Tall

Yarn:

385 Yards fingering weight in Main Color (MC)

195 yards fingering weight in Contrasting Color (CC)

Needles:

US Size 5 (3.75mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge:

19.5 stitches = 4" in stockinette on washed and blocked swatch.

Materials:

1 stitch marker

Tapestry needle for weaving in ends

Abbreviations:

MC – Main Color

CC – Contrasting Color



Pattern

With Main Color, cast on 280 stitches and join to knit in the round, making sure not to twist your stitches before joining. Place a stitch marker to mark the beginning of round.

Round 1: Purl
Round 2: Knit

Repeat these two rows 3 MORE times

Purl 1 round

Tip:

Don't break the yarn at every color change. Carry the yarn up the inside, by twisting the working and non-working yarn around each other at the beginning of the round. Less ends to weave in!

Stripes: Written directions below, or follow chart for row repeat.

Round 1: Join CC and knit all stitches
Round 2: Knit
Round 3: Switch to MC and knit all stitches
Round 4: Purl
Round 5: Switch to CC and knit all stitches
Round 6: knit

Repeat rounds 3-6 **15 MORE** times. You will have a total of 17 stripes in the Contrasting Color.

Note: I used 1 ball of Mini Mochi (195yds) for the contrasting color on this, and I was left with less than 10 yards. If you are using the same yarn, or yarn with a similar yardage, keep an eye on the remaining yarn, you may have to leave one stripe off if your ball is a little short.

Finishing:

Break CC yarn and continue knitting with MC yarn.

Round 1: Knit
Round 2: Purl

Repeat these two rows 3 MORE times.

Knit 1 round

Bind off all stitches PURL-WISE loosely

Block to measurements, and weave in ends.
