

# Fiolet Princess Sweater

## **Materials**

1 Skein Red Heart Super Saver, Purple 1 Large Button Size 6 Crochet Hook Needle and Thread.

### **Notes:**

Chains in beginning of rounds do NOT count as first stitch unless otherwise stated.

#### Ch 63

Row 1: SC in 2<sup>nd</sup> chain from hook, and in next 7 chains, 3 SC in next chain, SC in next 11 chains, 3 SC in next chain, SC in next 18, 3 SC in next chain, SC in next 11, 3 SC in next chain, SC in next 9 chains.

Row 2-6: chain 2 HDC in each SC across, putting 3HDC in center SC of 3 SC group below.

**Row 7**: ch 2, HDC to center of 3HDC, chain 10, skip to next 3HDC. HDC to next 3 HDC. Chain 10, HDC to end.

**Row 8**: SC in each stitch across

**Row 9**: chain 1, DC in first stitch, \*SC in next stitch, DC in next stitch\* repeat from \* across.

Row 10: SC in each stitch across.

Row 11: SC in first st and in next ch, chain 3. \*skip next 2 chs SC in next ch, ch 2 skip next ch, sc in next ch, ch3, repeat from \* across to last 4 chs, skip next 2 chs, SC in last 2 chs.

**Row 12**: ch 3 (counts as first DC) turn. DC in first SC, ch 3, SC in next ch 3 space, ch 3. \*3 DC in next ch 2 sp, ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 3, repeat from \* across to last 2 sc, skip next sc. 2 DC in last sc.

**Row 13**: ch 4 (counts as first DC, plus ch 1) turn. SC in next ch 3 sp, ch 2, sc in next ch 3 space. \*ch 3, sc in next ch 3 sp, ch 2 sc in next ch 3 sp. Repeat from \* across to last 2 DC, ch 1, skip next dc, dc in last dc.

Row 14: ch1, turn, SC in first DC ch 2, skip next ch 1 sp, 3 DC in next ch 2 sp, ch 2 \*sc in next ch 3 sp, 3 DC in next ch 2 sp, ch 2. \*SC in next ch 3 sp, ch 2, 3 DC in next ch 2 sp, ch 2. Repeat from \* across to last ch 1 sp, skip last ch 1 space, sc in last dc.

**Row 15**: ch 1, turn, SC in first SC, and in next ch 2 space, ch 3 \*SC in next ch 2 space, ch 2 SC in next ch 2 space, ch 3, repeat from \* across to last ch 2 space, SC in last ch 2 space, and in last sc.

**Row 16-22**: Repeat rows 11-15

Turn so edge of the cardigan is facing you. Sc evenly along the front, and neckline. Turn and sc another row, making button holes by chaining and skipping sc's.

#### Arms

Attach yarn in center bottom of the armhole. Chain 3, dc in each stitch around.

**Row 1-5**: Hdc in each stitch around

Row 6: ch 2, hdc 2 together twice. And then hdc in each stitch around

Row 7. Hdc in each stitch

Row8: ch 2, hdc 2 together once. And then hdc in each stitch around

Row 9-16L hdc in each stitch

Row 17: reverse single crochet in each stitch

Fasten off and weave in ends, and repeat for other arm.

Sew on buttons. I used one big button for this project. You can however customize it to what you want. I also only made the arms 3/4 length because my daughter dislikes the longer sleeves.

You can make this cardigan larger by doing 11 dc, 13 dc, 22 dc, 13 dc, 11 dc. Which will make a larger yoke. Or smaller by doing lets say for a 0-3 month 5 dc, 7 dc, 10 dc, 7 dc, 5 dc on the beginning chain.
