A Girly Hat

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Intermediate:

Size: Ladies Small, child's large

Finished measurements:

Circumference:

Child: approx 17" with DK

Adult: approx 20" with Worsted

Gauge: (stockinette worked in the round)

DK: 48 st x 32 rows = 4" in

Worsted: 26 st x 32 rows = 4"

Materials: 1 Skein Dk, Worsted or Aran Yarn (shown in The Wool Dispensary Useful Restorative / Danse Du Ventre; DK and Mountain Colors 4/8 wool / Canyon; Worsted

Needles: Size 6, 7 or 8 needles (size recommended for yarn used)

Notions: stitch marker and darning needle

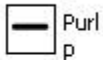
Terms and Abbreviations:

Dpn – double point needle

K – Knit

Stockinette – knit all stitches in round

p2tog

Directions:

Cast on 96 stitches evenly divided over 3 dpns, join to work in the round being careful not to twist.

Cuff:

Work 2 rounds K1, P1, ribbing, and then work 10 rounds in pattern as follows:

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4	3	2	1	
—	—	—	—	2
/○	/○	/○	/○	1

Stitch Pattern (Multiple of 4 stitches):
 Round 1: yo, p2tog, yo, p2tog
 Round 2: p4

After completing 10 pattern rounds (more can be worked if deeper cuff is desired), work 10 more rounds k1, p1, ribbing, then switch to stockinette and continue knitting around until work measures 5" above ribbing.

Begin crown shaping:

Decrease 6 stitches as follows:

Round 1: *K14, K2tog, repeat from * around

Round2: knit

Repeat these two rounds working 1 less stitch between decreases (K13, K12, etc.) until 60 stitches remain, then work decrease round only until 6 stitches remain.

Finishing: Cut thread and draw through, remaining stitches, fasten off, weave in loose ends. Block lightly. Embellish with pom-pom if desired.
