Supplies:

US 5 DPNs needles -3.75mm Worsted weight yarn Scrap yarn darning needle

Directions-

CO 51 sts in the round.

Seed stitch for 4 rounds.

K2tog, knit the rest.

Knit for 6 rounds.

Decreases-

K8, K2tog, all around. 45sts

Knit 3 rounds.

K7, K2tog, all around. 40 sts

Knit 2 rounds.

K6, K2tog, all around. 35 sts

Knit 1 round.

K5, K2tog, all around. 30 sts

Knit 1 round.

K4, K2tog, all around. 25 sts

Knit 1 round.

K3, K2tog, all around. 20 sts

Knit 1 round.

K4, K2tog to the last 2 sts., K2 17sts

K2, K2tog, Knit to the end. 16 sts

Set up for the tail fins-

You should have 16 stitches in all.

K8, place the next 8 stitches onto scrap yarn.

Tail Fins-

Distribute stitches onto DPNs.

Knit 1 round.

K2, KFB, K2, KFB, K2 (12 sts)

K3, KFB, K2, KFB, K3 (14 sts)

K4, KFB, K2, KFB, K4 (16 sts)

K5, KFB, K2, KFB, K5

Knit 4 rounds.

K1, SSK, K2, K2tog, K2, SSK, K2, K2tog, K1

K1, SSK, K2tog, K2, SSK, K2tog, K1

SSK, K2tog, SSK, K2tog

Cut yarn and pull it through remaining 4 stitches. Weave in ends.

Repeat for the second fin.

Dorsal Fin-

CO 24 stitches in the round.

Seed stitch for 2 rounds.

SSK, K8, K2tog, SSK, K8, K2tog

SSK, K6, K2tog, SSK, K6, K2tog

SSK, K4, K2tog, SSK, K4, K2tog

SSK, K2, K2tog, SSK, K2, K2tog

SSK, K2tog, SSK, K2tog

Cut yarn and pull it through the remaining stitches.

Sew the dorsal fin centered in between the tail fins towards the border of the hat.

Weave in ends.
