Flowery Hat #1



Requirements:



Instructions:

- 5 x 5½mm or 6mm DP needles
- SENALES yarn, 100g/125m, color #123, lot #12827
- Tapestry needle
- 6 mm (US size J) Crochet hook

Longtail CO – 85 sts for small sized hat (87 for medium, 90 for large)

The hat (knitting):

- 1. Knit in rib stitch for 6 rows.
- 2. Knit in stockinette stitch for 11 rows
- 3. Knit in garter stitch for 6 rows
- 4. Knit in stockinette stitch for 20 rows for size S (24 for M, 28 for L)

- 5. K3, K3tog
- 6. Purl across
- 7. Repeat #5 and #6 until you have 7 9 stitches left.
- 8. Cut the yarn, leaving 15 inches and secure the remaining stitches using a tapestry needle. Weave in the rest of the yarn.

The flower (crocheting):

- 1. Start off with 6 chains.
- 2. Slip stitch into the first chain to create you center circle
- 3. Chain 6, slip stitch into circle. This makes our first petal.
- 4. Repeat #3 four more times until you are left with five petals (you can do up to 8 petals in this manner)
- 5. Slip stitch through the first petal and do 3 chains, wrap your yarn around your crochet hook once and then slip it through the petal circle. You're left with 3 loops.
- 6. Slip stitch through the first loop (3 left), then through first two loops (2 left) and finally through the last two remaining loops.
- 7. Repeat #5 and 6# two more times (3 altogether) to finish your first petal.
- 8. Repeat #7 for all the other petals and secure your yarn.

Finishing:

- Using a crochet hook, pick a side where your flower will be and while picking up knitted stitches (from the top of your hat), make chains until you reach the ribbing of your crown.
- Using a tapestry needle, sew in your flower to a desired side of your hat where you knitted your garter stitch rows.
- Wear it with pride and joy!
