RLEVET SOCKS



MATERIAL

Yarn Knit Pick Felici(218 yard/50g) Needles dpns 2.25 mm / US 1 size

SISE

To fit a 38.5 /39 size foot Medium

ABBREVIATION

k: knit p: purl M: increase St: stitch

TOE

Cast on 20 st. with either figure-eight, Turkish or Judy's magic Knit 1 row dividing the stitches on 4 needles (5 st. per needles). Then begin toe increase: Row 1: (k1, M1, k19, M1) 2 x Row 2: k Row 3: (k1, M1, k21, M1) 2x Row 4: k Repeat these 2 rows until you have 60 stitches (15 st. on each needles)

FOOT

Then begin chart at row 1, knitting the sole in stockinette stitch. Knit following the chart until you have 5 cm less than the total foot length.

HEEL

At this point, begin the short row heel as follow: Row 1: knit the sole stitches (29 st) to one st, before end, turn the work Row 2: sl 1 purlwise with yarn in front, then pull the working yarn to the back of the work until the stitch of the row below makes a double st.(sl1p) purl (27 st) to 1 st. before end turn the work. Row 3: sl1p, knit 26 st. to double stitch turn the work. Row 4: sl1p, purl 25 st, turn the work Row 5: sl1p, knit 24 st. to double stitch turn the work. Row 6: sl1p, purl 23 st, turn the work Row 7: sl1p, knit 22 st. turn the work. Row 8: sl1p, purl 21 st, turn the work Row 9: sl1p, knit 20 st. turn the work. Row 10: sl1p, purl 19 st, turn the work Row 11: sl1p, knit 18 st. turn the work. Row 12: sl1p, purl 17 st, turn the work Row 13: sl1p, knit 16 st. turn the work. Row 14: sl1p, purl 15 st, turn the work Row 15: sl1p, knit 14 st. turn the work. Row 16: sl1p, purl 13 st, turn the work Row 17: sl1p, knit 12 st. turn the work. Row 18: sl1p, purl 11 st, turn the work Row 19: sl1p, knit 10 st. turn the work. Row 20: sl1p, purl 9 st, turn the work Row 21: sl1p, knit 8 st., knit the 9 double stitches, knit last st. turn the work. Row 22: sl1p, purl 17 st, purl the 9 double st., purl last st. turn the work Row 23: sl1p, knit 18 st. turn the work. Row 24: sl1p, purl 9 st, turn the work Row 25: sl1p, k8, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 26: sli1p, p 9, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 27: sl1p, k10, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 28: sli1p, p 11, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 29: sl1p, k12, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 30: sli1p, p 13, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 31: sl1p, k14, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 32: sli1p, p 15, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 33: sl1p, k16, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 34: sli1p, p 17, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 35: sl1p, k18, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 36: sli1p, p 19, p1 double st., p1 turn the work

Row 37: sl1p, k20, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 38: sli1p, p 21, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 39: sl1p, k22, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 40: sli1p, p 23, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 42: sl1p, k24, k1 double st, k1 turn the work Row 40: sli1p, p 25, p1 double st., p1 turn the work Row 41: sl1p, k26, k 2 double st. The heel is now complete. Continue in pattern for the next 30 st., k the 2 double st, then knit to end of row.

LEG

Continue following the chart on all the 60 stitches around, until you reach the desired length.

FINISHING

Continue in p1, k1 for ribbing for the desired length. . Knit another row with a sl1 with yarn in front, k1. Knit the last row with a p1, sl1 with yarn in back.

After these 2 last rows you cast-off with an Italian cast-off (tubular cast-off) Et voilà.
