DRAGEE SOCKS

RY STEFANINA, @ DECEMBER 2008



MATERIAL

Yarn City Wool Alpha MC in light blue (220 m/50g) 1 skein Sommer Wolle CC in purple variegated (220 m/50g) about skein Bernetta Wolle Grilana CC in light rose (220 m/50g) about 1 skein Needles dpns 2.25mm / US 1 size

NOTE

If you want to make your sock longer, you may need more than 1 skein of the MC. The pattern is a multiple of 3 st, so you can make your sock bigger by adding 3, 6 or 9 st for the circumference.

SIZE

To fit a 38-39 European size foot Small/Medium (22cm of foot circumference)

GAUGE

30 st / 42 rows = 10 cm / 4" over stockinette stitch

ABBREVIATION

- ❖ k: knit
- **❖** p: p
- * ktbl: knit through back loop
- ❖ M: increase
- ❖ st: stitch
- * wat: wrap next stitch and turn the work
- wst: wrapped stitch
- * kwst: knit the stitch with his wrap
- pwst: purl the stitch with his wrap
- ❖ MC: main color
- CC: contrasting color

TOE

With MC cast on 20 st with figure-eight cast-on, Turkish cast-on or Judy's magic cast-on. Then knit 1 round dividing the stitches on 4 needles (5 st per needles).

Toe increase:

- 1. Row: (k1, M1, k9, M1) 2 x
- 2. Row: k
- 3. Row: (k1, M1, k11, M1) 2x
- 4. Row: k

Repeat row 3 and 4 until you have 60 stitches (15 st on each needles), knit one more row, transferring one 1 st from the sole to the instep.

FOOT

Begin Bonbonnière sock chart for the instep stitches (31 st), the sole stitches (29 st) are always knitted.

Continue working the foot following Bonbonnière sock chart from row 1 to 9; until you reach 5 cm /2" less than desired length, stopping after completing row 6.

Here: 19 cm/7.5" worked, to obtain 24 cm/9.5" for the total length.

Knit the first 30 instep st in MC following the row 7 of chart. The last st will be transferred to the sole st for knitting the heel.

HEEL

At this point, begin the short row heel as follow with MC:

 Row: k 29 (sole st), wrap last st, 	22.Row: p 19, p 9 wrapped st(pwst),

7. Row: k 23, w&t.	27.Row: k 12, kwst, w&t
8. Row: p 22, w&t	28.Row: p 13, pwst, w&t
9. Row: k 21 w&t.	29.Row: k 14, kwst, w&t
10. Row: p 20, w&t	30.Row: p 15, pwst, w&t
11. Row: k 19, w&t.	31. Row: k 16, kwst, w&t
12. Row: p 18, w&t	32.Row: p 17, pwst, w&t
13. Row: k 17, w&t.	33.Row: k 18, kwst, w&t
14. Row: p 16, w&t	34.Row: p 19, pwst, w&t
15. Row: k 15, w&t.	35.Row: k 20, kwst, w&t
16. Row: p 14, w&t	36.Row: p 21, pwst, w&t
17. Row: k 13, w&t.	37.Row: k 22, kwst, w&t
18. Row: p 12, w&t	38.Row: p 23, pwst, w&t
19. Row: k 11, w&t.	39.Row: k 24, kwst, w&t
20.Row: p 10, w&t	40.Row: p 25, pwst, w&t
21. Row: k 10, k 9 wrapped st(wst),	41. Row: k 26, k 2 wst
w&t (the last st is double	

The heel is now complete. Continue in pattern where you stopped before the heel for the next 30 st, and knit to end of row.

Continue working following Dragée sock pattern chart from where you stopped on the whole stitches, until you reach the desired length for the leg, stopping after completing row 9, cut CC, and knit 2 more rounds in MC.

CUFF

Continue in p1, k1 for ribbing for the desired length. Knit another row with a sl1 with yarn in front, k1. Knit the last row with a p1, sl1 with yarn in back.

After these 2 last rows you cast-off with an Italian cast-off (tubular cast-off).


FINISHING

Weave in end all the thread.
