## J-J SOCKS



MATERIAL
Yarn Sommer Wolle Marathon Color ( $400 \mathrm{~m} / 437$ yard $/ 100 \mathrm{~g}$ )
Needles dpns $2.5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} 1.5$ size
size
To fit a 44-45 size foot Large (Men size)

## gauge

$30 \mathrm{st} / 44$ rows $=10 \mathrm{~cm} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ over stockinette stitch
ABBREVIATION

* k: knit
* $\mathrm{p}: \mathrm{p}$
* $M$ : increase
* st: stitch
* w\&t : wrap next stitch and turn the work.


## TOE

Cast on 24 st with either figure-eight, Turkish or Judy's magic
Knit 1 row dividing the stitches on 4 needles ( 6 st per needles). Then begin toe increase:
Row 1: (k1, M1, k11, M1) $2 \times$
Row 2: k
Row 3: (k1, M1, k13, M1) $2 x$
Row 4: k
Repeat these 2 last rows until you have 64 stitches ( 16 st on each needles)

FOOT
SET-UP row: p1, *k4, p1, k3, p1* (repeat from * to * 3 times), k4, p1, knit 31 (sole st). You have transferred 1 st from the sole to the instep after knitting this first row; you have 33 instep st and 31 sole st.

Then begin J-J sock foot chart for the instep st., the sole st are knitted.
Knit following the chart until you have 4.5 cm less than desired length.(here 20 cm , to obtain 24.5 cm for the total length), you have 64 st ( 33 st for instep and 31 st for sole). Remember at which row you stopped.

## HEEL

At this point, begin the short row heel as follow:

Row 1: k 30 st of the sole stitches, wrap next st, turn the work
Row 2: p 29 st, wrap last st, turn the work
Row 3: k 28 st w\& $\dagger$
Row 4: p 27 st, w\&t
Row 5: k 26 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 6: p 25 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 7: $\mathrm{k} 24 \mathrm{st}, \mathrm{w} \&$
Row 8: p 23 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 9: k 22 st w\&t.
Row 10: p 21 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 11: k 20 st w\&t.
Row 12: p 19 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 13: k 18 st w\&t.
Row 14: p 17 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 15: k 16 st w\&t.
Row 16: p 15 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 17: k 14 st w\&t.
Row 18: p 13 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 19: k 12 st w\& $\dagger$.
Row 20: p 11 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 21: k 10 st w\&t.
Row 22: p 9 st, w\&t
Row 23: k 9 st, k the 10 wrapped st, w\&t, the last $s t$ is double wrapped

Row 24: p 19 st, p the 10 wrapped st, w\&t, the last $s t$ is double wrapped
Row 25: k 19, w\&t.
Row 26: p 9 st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 27: k 9, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 28: p 10 p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 29: k 11, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 30: p 12, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 31: k 13, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 32: p 14, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 33: k 15, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 34: p 16, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 35: k 17, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 36: p 18, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 37: k 19, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 38: p 20, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 39: k 21, kw st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 40: p 22, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 41: k 23, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 42: p 24, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 43: k 25, k w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 44: p 26, p w st, w\& $\dagger$
Row 45: k 27, k 2 w s

The heel is now complete. Continue in pattern for the next $33 s t$, knit the 2 double $s t$, and knit to end of row.

## LEG

Continue following the J-J sock chart where you stopped, for the front leg stitches and from column. 2 to column 32 of the chart, for back leg stitches. (The purled stitches from columns 1 and 33 of the chart are not repeated in the back leg). Continue in this manner until you reach the desired length for the leg (here I've knitted 3.5 pattern repeats).

## FINISHING

Then continue in $\mathrm{p} 1, \mathrm{k} 1$ for ribbing for the desired length.
Note that here in this pattern I have increased 1 st between the 4 knitted stitches all around to keep the continuity of the pattern in the ribbing, 8 st increased in the ribbing part.
Knit another row with a sl1 with yarn in front, k1. Knit the last row with a p1, s11 with yarn in back.
After these 2 last rows you cast-off with an Italian cast-off (tubular cast-off) Et voilà.
