## <u>Daisies in diagonals</u> <u>Motif for shawls</u>



## Introduction

This pattern is a new variation of the motif **16.** Little daisies. In this version tiny flowers are placed to form diagonals with empty space inside.

This pattern includes interesting lace stitch, when odd number of stitches is knitted together and the same amount of stitches is raised from them.

## Description and tips

Charts 1 shows only odd rows, purl all even row stitches.

Edge and middle part of the motif are separated by the empty space.

Edge stitches are not included into the chart.

To include motif into your knitting count needed amount of stitches as: 29 sts (edges of the motif) + 20 sts  $\cdot X$  times (repeated middle part of the motif). Knit repeating 1 - 48 rows of the chart 1.
