## School Spiril Hat

Supplies:
5 dpns - US size 8
1 US size $101 / 2$ circular needle - $29^{\prime \prime}$
Approximately 100 yards in your main color, a worsted weight yarn will work best
Approximately 9 yards in a contrasting color
About $11 / 2$ yds of $1 / 2$ inch ribbon to match your contrasting color
Tapestry needle


Method:
CO 72 stitches on size 8 dpns via long-tail cast on in your main color. Leave a tail long enough that you can knit the first row with your working yarn and the tail.

Join to work in the round.

Work 7-8 rows (your preference really) in $1 \times 1$ ribbing (K1, P1).

Change to size 10.5 circulars, and use the magic loop method until the increase, and after the decreases.

Row 1: Knit
Row 2: Knit
Row 3: K1, yo, K2tog
Row 4: K2, make one
(there should be 108 stitches at this point)

Rows12-13: Knit in contrasting color
Rows 14-15: Knit in main color
Rows 16-17: Knit in contrasting color
Rows 18-20: Knit in main color
Row 21: K1, K2tog
(72 stitches)
Row 22: Knit
Row 23: K1, K2tog (48 stitches left)

Row 24: Knit
Row 25: K6, K2tog
Row 26: K5, K2tog
Row 27: Contrasting color - K4, K2tog
Row 28: Contrasting color - K3, K2tog
Row 29: K2, K2tog
Row 30: K1, K2tog
Row 31: K2tog


There should be six stitches left at this point. Cut a long tail and weave it through the live stitches then pull it tight and weave in the ends. Weave in all ends from color work.

Add ribbon by weaving into holes in Row 3.

I hope you enjoy this pattern - it's fun and pretty quick to make!
