Crocheted Cast Iron Handle Covers

This pattern includes a large and small version. The small works for my 8" skillet as well as my 12" skillet. The large I made to go with my 10" round griddle as the handle is longer and a little fatter.



MATERIALS

Cotton Yarn Size G (4.25 mm) crochet hook

TERMS & ABBREVIATIONS

Chain = ch Single crochet = sc Half double crochet = hdc Decrease = sc2tog: Pull up a loop in each of the next 2 stitches, yarn over and pull through all 3 loops on hook.

DIRECTIONS *Instructions will be for the small size with large size in brackets.*

Make 4. Ch 8 [10] Start in the 2nd ch from hook.

Work 1sc in each ch across, ch 1, turn. - 7[9]sc.
Work 1sc in each sc, ch 1, turn.


3. Work (1sc in next st, ch 1, skip the next stitch) x3, 1sc in last st, ch 1, turn.

4. Work 1sc in next sc, 1sc in ch-1 space, across, ch 1, turn.

5 - 13. Repeat rows 2-4 three times more. [13b. Lg size ONLY: Sc2tog, sc in each of next 5 sts, sc2tog, ch 1, turn = 7sc.] 14. Sc2tog, sc in each of next 3 sts, sc2tog, ch 1, turn = 5sc. 15. Sc2tog, 1sc, Sc2tog = 3sc. Bind off. Weave in ends.

TO ASSEMBLE

Stack the 4 layers together and attach yarn at the bottom right corner



Now you will separate the layers at the bottom opening and will be crocheting



small, but two more for the large.

only 2 layers together, working into the beginning chain.

Sc across the beginning chain to the other side, add an extra sc at the side where the layers join, sc across the beginning chain on the other two layers, add an extra sc at the side. Do not bind off.

Try on the handle cover and see if you need one or two or more rows added. I only added one more row for the

When you get to your last row, on the backside switch to hdc for half a round, end with 1sc at the side. Bind off.

Variation: The ch-1 spaces were added for visual effect, if a more solid handle cover is desired simply sc each row. Or make two layers that are solid and 2 layers that have the ch-1 spaces. When layering have the 2 solid pieces on the inside.
