

# Poppy pin cushion crochet pattern

You will need:

Red yarn  
Green yarn  
Black yarn  
4 mm hook  
Tapestry needle

## UK terms used throughout. Translation into US terms here:

Triple treble crochet (ttr) – US Double treble crochet (dtr) – yarn over three times.

Double treble crochet (dtr) = US Treble/triple crochet (tr) – yarn over twice.

Treble crochet (tr) = US Double crochet (dc).

Double crochet (dc) = US Single crochet (sc).

Chain and slip stitches are the same for both terminologies.

Start with green yarn to make the stem. Either chain 4 and slip stitch into the first chain to make a circle, or make a magic circle.

Round 1: Crochet 12 double crochet into the circle (12).

Round 2: Crochet 2 dc into each stitch from previous round (24).

Round 3: Crochet 1 dc into each stitch from previous round – front loops only (24).

Rounds 4 – 8: 1 dc into each stitch from previous round (both loops) (24).

Fasten off and stuff well.



Switch to black yarn, either chain 4 and slip stitch into the first chain to make a circle, or make a magic circle.

Round 1: Crochet 12 double crochet into the circle (12).

Round 2: Crochet 2 dc into each stitch from previous round (24).

Switch to red yarn.

Round 3: Using slip stitches, attach this red circle to your green stem (24 slip stitches).

To make the petals:

Petal 1: [Chain 3. DTR into same stitch. TTR twice into next 2 stitches. 2 DTR into next stitch. TR and DC into next stitch. Slip stitch into next.]

Petal 2: [Chain 3. DTR into same stitch. TTR twice into next 2 stitches. TR and DC into next stitch. Slip stitch into next.]

Petal 3: Repeat petal 1.

Petal 4: Repeat petal 2.

Fasten off and sew in ends.
